HON. RECORDER'S REPORT

Mr. President and Gentlemen,

In presenting my report, I would like to stress to all members, the importance to those persons responsible for the 'phoning of progress scores and results of matches to the Recorder each week. The majority of teams co-operated in this regard, but as usual there were the few teams who did not show the slightest interest whatsoever despite continual reminders and numerous fines incurred. In order to publish results in the Sydney Morning Herald and the local press, details of play had to be in my hands not later than Sunday evening each week. A relatively simple job was made very difficult by a minority of individuals who apparently couldn't care less if their team's scores were published or not.

I would like to thank those members who telephoned me the results regularly in the specified times, and in particular to Ray Noakes of the Engadine Hotel Club, who each week without fail gave me details of his three teams scores, regardless of whether they were playing at home or away.

Some very fine individual efforts were recorded throughout the season, including the very rare feat of ten wickets in one innings. Harold Claverie of Gymea Rexonians accomplished this against Caringbah Church of Christ for 28 runs. He also bagged a total of 116 wickets including three hat-tricks.

John Philip of Engadine Hotel narrowly missed out on a thousand runs for the season with 948. He had bad luck in his last innings of the season when he was out without scoring.

Cronulla Caringbah League established a record tenth wicket partnership in an A.L. match against Miranda Rangers, S. Watt 37 n.o. and A. Milne 82, added 124 runs including extras.

In the B.3. Grade, Miranda R.S.L. lost only their last two matches and finished with 110 points. They won nine matches outright, and three on the first innings. Woolcooware with 106 points ran a close second.

An interesting feature of the individual awards was a complete sweep by Sutherlands Grays point in the B.2. Grade. Following are full details of all averages.

H. Claverie performed the most unique statistics for this Association, in 1964-65 season for Gymea Rexonians in taking 116 wickets, embracing three hat tricks, also with 7 for 1 Versus Woolooware two hat tricks, the side being dismissed for 14 runs. He bowled 3.4 overs in doing this. Took his 10 wickets in 8.5 overs. Versus Jannali 9-38 including the hat trick off 9 overs, in the 1st innings and 6-15 including the hat trick in 6 overs, 2nd innings.

W. Wakely Tramway v. Sylvania, secured the 14 wickets which fell Season 1930-31. On first day he took 10 for 40 and scored 110 runs in the same afternoon. On second day he took the 4 wickets that fell, before rain stopped play. This is without a doubt the greatest performance ever recorded in the history of the Association.

In ten matches, season 1930-31, W. Wakely scored 579 runs at an average of 41.35, and took 76 wickets at an average of 9.79.

In the 1929-30 season the first three batsmen for Sutherland all scored centuries in the same innings: W. Wakely 103, A. Eagles 126 n.o., and J. Baker 103.
