We also have prepared an up to date copy of the Constitution, with minutes that have been passed during the last few years, and with further recomendations from your Committee.

The interest shown during the past year has been excellent, no doubt due to the efforts of Ian Chappell's men overseas. It is a pity that we hadn't the opportunity to see the South African Team whilst in their full glory.

Congratulations to all who have helped during the season, the winners of the various Grades and trophy winners.

HON. SECRETARY'S REPORT

Mr. President & Gentlemen,

The 1972/73 season saw a vast increase in the number of registered members and affiliated teams. This increase was reflected throughout the Sydney Metropolitan Area and officials of the N.S.W. Junior Cricket Union anticipate that the past season will establish an all time record of players.

MEMBERSHIP

Twenty four clubs again affiliated with our Association, but the number of teams increased from 41 to 52 and the registered members jumped from 747 to 913. The Boys' Competition also catered for greatly increased numbers, from 83 teams and 1104 registered members (1971/72 season), to 134 teams and 1747 registered members for the past season, making an all time record of 186 teams and 2,660 registered members.

New clubs to affiliate were Port Hacking Businessmens: Club and St John Bosco. Many clubs entered additional teams, while Bundeena R.S.L. and Salecians did not seek re affiliation.

GROUNDS Every available ground was brought into use, and if indications are correct, then the ground situation for the ensuing season will become acute if a further anticipated increase in teams materialise.

GRADING

Although the Executive Committee endeavoured to have team nominations and registrations submitted by the specified date, difficulties were encountered when this mandatory ruling was not fully complied with. In the interests of cricket the Executive went ahead and graded all teams without full information being available. Subsequently, the Executive was crtisized in certain quarters for allegedly not grading certain teams correctly. A resolution now on the books will debar any team whic does not submit a registration form with all relevent information, and financial obligations by the specified date.

The grading of 52 teams presented many difficulties, with the A1 Grade proving the hardest to grade. There does not appear to be sufficient teams of true Al standard.

Teams were eventually graded into seven grades with six in A1 and B4, and eight teams in A2, A3, B1, B2 and B3.

SHELL COMPANY INTER-ASSOCIATION COMPETITIONS

Our Daily Telegraph Shield Team fought its way into the final against Western Suburbs with an unbeaten record, but had to be content with a draw when rain interupted play. Western suburbs defended stubbornly with only one wicket to fall and 26 runs to get, when rain finally sent the players hurrying to shelter with about ten minutes of play remaining.

The Martin Shield Team appeared a little stronger on paper this season and was perhaps a little unlucky not to finish higher in the points score.

The John Durham Shield Team contained many new players and this team did not do so well as anticipated. Coupled with a bye and rain affected matches the team never really got into stride. However, if the same players are available for selection during the coming season, there is no doubt that with the experience gained this season, the team will be a much stronger combination.

This Association was honoured, in so far as the Junior Cricket Union selected the three turf wickets in the Shire for the playing of the finals.

RESULTS OF INTER ASSOCIATION FINALS

Martin Shield: Telegraph Shield: Durham Shield: N.S.W.Catholics 7 - 104 defeated Newcastle 81. Sutherland 191 drew with Western Surburbs 9 - 155. Parramatta 133 drew with St.George 6 - 103.

Due to our Telegraph Team playing a draw with Western Surburbs, both teams will be declared joint premiers.

REX KING TROPHY

The District Club, as in former years, proved too strong for our representative teams, winning two and tying the other. Once again it was the Daily Telegraph side that had the Grade boys worried. Unfortunately, the scores of this match have been misplaced so that the boys who did well can not be publicised, however to the whole team we say "Well done." Our congratulations go to the victorious teams of the District Club, and warn that we will be in there fighting once again this coming season.

SPORTSMAN OF THE YEAR AWARD

The Annual Captain Cook Sportsman of the Year Award conducted by the Sutherland Shire Council was awarded to President Jack Edwards in July last year. This coverted award was richly deserved by Jack who has unselfishly devoted many years towards junior sport, not only cricket, but also other codes.

RUSS LUXFORD

After serving continuously on the Association Executive Committee for 25 years, Russ last season decided not to seek re-election. His record as an administrator is most impressive and his devotion to whatever position he filled was carried out with enthusiasm and dedication. Russ was in attendance at the inaugural meeting of the Association in 1947 and he was the first Association President, and first Life Member. He held the position of President for a total of five years, Senior Vice President for one year, Secretary three years, and sixteen years as Treasurer, where he was really "Par Excellance". In addition, he was for many years our delegate to the Sports Advisory Committee.

In appreciation of Russ's service to the Association, a Testim ial Dinner was held in his honour at Taren Point Bowling Club in Novembelast year, when the President, Jack Edwards presented a suitably inscriwatch to him. The dinner was well attended with many dignitaries presheaded by Shire President, Ray Thorburn.

LIVE MEDBER

In the past season Life Membership of the Association was conferred on Wal. Anderson, a great stalwart of the Umpires Association. Wal has a long cricket history going back to the 1918-19 season when he played competition cricket with the Miranda Club. Wal recalls that eights teams played in Association matches in those days, including a team from Helensburgh.

Wal played regularly in the Shire until 1932 when he decided to take up umpiring. He umpired for two years in the Shire and became a Grade umpire in 1934 where he officiated regularly until 1958, including matches on the Sydney Cricket Ground. From 1958 to 1963 he was a G.P.S. umpire and came back to the Shire in 1963, umpiring Association matches until the present time.

Association members remember Wal as an umpire who very rarely gave a wrong decision, and we wish him many more years of umpiring.

BUILDING FUND

Attempts to raise a considerable sum of money towards the building fund received little support from members despite early indications by the delogates that their clubs would participate. Ken Murphy and Alan McKillop gave a tremendous amount of their time and energies towards a fund raising scheme to be held in conjunction with a dinner where it was hoped to present a brand new motor car to a lucky participant. The Executive was faced with the problem of going ahead with the scheme and possibly losing hundreds of dollars or dropping the scheme entirely. A compromise was reached, the dinner went ahead, but the planned giant raffle was abandoned. The decision to levy all clubs was not well received, but the facts must be faced. This Association together with the Boys' Competition and the District Clubwere committed at the time to support the building fund to the maximum.

Sincere thanks are recorded to Ken Murphy and Alan McKillop for the stirling job they did in conjunction with the scheme, which unfortunately never really got off the ground.

SILVER JUBILEE DINNER

The Silver Jubilee Dinner and Presentation Night was fully booked with an attendance of over 370 people. There is no doubt that this was the most successful dinner to-date, and our thanks are recorded to the management of Taren Point Bowling Club for its co-operation in making the Club available, and the assistance we received.

GENERA L

The past season has been another successful one, but created many headaches for your Executive with a variety of problems, which in the main were overcome. Many problems, including grading, registrations, grounds and the draw occur each year and there does not appear to be a set formula or easy answer to these difficulties. Each year many clubs are unfinancial for long periods, and towards the end of the season over \$1,200 was outstanding in match fees etc. by the clubs. At one stage the Executive was considering taking action under the rules of default to recover the outstanding debts, but fortunately this drastic action was not necessary. At the time of preparing this report, the Executive is attempting to revise the Rules and By-Laws of the Association for the consideration by the delegates to assist in the smoother running of the Association. A little more co-operation, particularly by some club secretaries and the treasurers, would assist the cause, but short of reading the Riot Act it is almost impossible to stir some club officials into action.

Transversly, I would like to pay credit where credit is due. Vince Ridge and his helpers did a mighty job looking after the coir matting and on the whole they received co-operation from the club members who now possibly realize what an expensive item the mats have become.

John Boon, our new treasurer, was a last minute appointment when Russ Luxford stepped down from the job, and he, like the rest of the Executive have learned what an asset Russ was to the Association relating to matters of finance. John stepped into the job when all nominees declined and admirably looked after our finances.

Monty Perry, as usual made work for himself by compiling endless statistics, bulletins and match reports and an easy to read "complicated" draw with a specially borrowed typewriter that enabled him to type a wealth of information in a very small space.

Jack Edwards, who admitted that due to pressure of business he was unable this season to devote his time as fully as he would have liked to Association affairs. Despite this, Jack carried out his duties as President in a most capable manner.

Bob "Shorthand" Davey was ever ready to assist in any matter outside his Assistant Secretary duties which he despatched in a very work-manlike manner. I would like to pay my respects to Bob and state that I could not have wished for a better assistant. It is now common knowledge that I do not propose to stand for office next season, and if Bob is willing to accept nomination I feel that he would be an asset to the Association in the position of Secretary.

I feel that I must dwell upon my retirement, a decision that was not reached lightly, for I have made many friends through the medium of cricket, and I hope no enchies; despite my criticism in previous chapters. A certain gentleman, who shall remain nameless, referred to me as the most "One Eyed Pommie" he'd ever met, a disputed fact that Jack Edwards and Vince Ridge constantly try to remind me of, and if England keep on winning Test Matches against Australia (as they seem to make a habit of recently), I wish to state that I am completely impartial.

Gentlemen, I thank you for putting up with me over the years, my sincere thanks to all those who have assisted me, the majority of club secretaries whom I have become closely associated with, and who do co-operate on Association affairs, everyone else who have contributed, selectors, term managers, umpires, delegates, committeemen etc. I thank you, and wish the Association continued success in the future.
