PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Ladies and Gentlemen,

My initial year as President has proved to be both challenging and rewarding. At the outset, I believed it was imperative to continue the drive demonstrated by previous executives, to foster cricket within the Sutherland Shire, and to work more closely with the Executives of the Grade Club and the Boys' Association.

I feel that I can confidently report that the present executive has moved with the times by progressive thinking which resulted in the introduction of many welcome innovations for the betterment of cricket in the area. The past year has seen the three bodies charged with promoting cricket in the shire working in a much more harmonious climate.

Overall, it has been a very difficult year for cricket, with so much publicity devoted to the 'war' between the Australian Cricket Board and the Packer controlled W.S.C. The disappointing form displayed by the Australian Test Team in some matches affected the support normally given by the public. Gate receipts were down to such an extent that the Board could not recoup the losses incurred in legal proceedings forced on it by the 'war'. Possibly the financial state in both camps, as huge losses were incurred by W.S.C. despite all the propaganda, forced the peace overtures.

Hopefully, cricket and players at all levels will benefit now that a compromise has been reached. But the doubt lingers that we will get too much cricket over a short period, with the added burden of those incessant commercials that drive one to distraction.

On the local scene, we too have experienced problems, particularly with the administration of Sunday cricket, shortage of grounds and the on-field behaviour of some teams.

The executive, over recent years, have been faced with greater team affiliations without any corresponding increase in playing fields. This forced the introduction of Sunday cricket. However, this concept proved to be most difficult to administer, and resulted in an increased workload for the Secretary, Recorder and the mat committee chairman. It is my firm conviction that future executives should try to avoid Sunday cricket, irrespective of the number of teams nominated.

The behaviour of some teams and individual players gives cause for great concern, and valuable time has been spent on hearings involving misconduct, including abuse of umpires and opposition players. The executive will not hesitate to punish offenders who are found guilty of gross misconduct. However, it must be appreciated that most incidents can be avoided by captains exercising their authority over team members. It is clearly part of a captain's duty to attempt to quell any situation that is likely to explode.

On the more positive side, I must say that it has been a pleasure to deal with the large majority of clubs teams and players, and the executive appreciate the cooperation given, especially in areas featuring new regulations. Any measures that are introduced by the executive are designed to benefit the association as a whole. When our efforts are appreciated it certainly encourages us to put even more into our work.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the secretary, Bob Davey, for his dedication, support and encouragement. To my fellow committee members I extend my appreciation for their wholehearted contribution, loyalty and assistance which have been most evident over the past year.

In conclusion, I wish all members of the association a very successful and happy season in 1979 - 80.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Fellow Cricketers,

Again it is my privilege to report on a successful season.

MEMBERSHIP

The season 1978 - 79 saw the affiliation of 38 clubs, with the omission of Menai Wanderers and the admission of Caringbah Bowlers and Cronulla Seagulls -- both well-administered and cooperative clubs.

Teams entered remained at 94, with the number of registered players dropping slightly to just under 1700.

GROUNDS

The ground situation remains tight, with not enough to allow all competition matches to be played on Saturdays, thus again requiring Sunday games. Despite the lack of available fields, the association cooperated with the NSW Protestant Churches Cricket Association by avoiding the use of three grounds.

The Association is indebted to Cronulla Sutherland Leagues Club for making available Endeavour Field; to Boys' Town for making available several wickets in its complex, and to Port Hacking High School for the use of its field.

SUTHERLAND SHIRE COUNCIL

The good relationship between the Council and its officers and our association has allowed for better running of our competitions. Eugene Morris and Denis Walker were ever helpful, and Shire Engineer, Eric Hirst and Parks and Playgrounds Engineer, Brian Baker, continued to give invaluable assistance and advice. Joe Starkey, Parks Supervisor, was again plagued by booking confusions, but he worked untiringly in his endeavours to keep everyone happy.

GRADING

Despite application of strict rules, the grading committee fell for some of the sob stories that inevitably come forth, hence engendering unbalanced results in several grades. No doubt the lesson has now been learned and the hard line approach will be applied, and clubs not grading realistically will have their teams re-assessed and regraded by the committee.

Late registrations have not been eliminated but certainly reduced considerably, obviously as a result of the eligibility for the first three rounds rule.

FINALS

All were affected by rain, but some were played to a result. Four minor premiers were defeated in the finals and a couple were saved by the rain. The association council meeting in July voted heavily in favour of finals being played in the 1979 - 80 season.

SELECTION COMMITTEE AND REPRESENTATIVE TEAMS

Selections were controlled by Committeeman Jim Field and teams were entered in the Martin, Telegraph and Durham Shield competitions. Congratulations to Gary Condon of Jannali Club on taking out the Telegraph Shield batting award and to Col Christie, also from Jannali for taking out the Telegraph Shield bowling award.

SPORTS ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO SUTHERLAND SHIRE COUNCIL

I represented our interests at these meetings and cooperated fully with other sports, bearing in mind our own needs.

STANDARDIZATION OF BALLS

The introduction of the use of a standard ball was most successful and gave an equality among teams that did not previously exist. This innovation allowed the association to arrange a sponsorship deal which resulted in the Durham Shield team being provided with a new kit valued at \$600. This sponsorship arrangement has enabled all clubs to purchase cricket balls at bedrock prices and has resulted in considerable savings. The executive has been pleased to receive commendations for the introduction of this scheme from a safety and savings point of view.

RULE CHANGES

Several rule changes were approved at our July meeting and will lead to better administration and easier understanding of playing requirements.

SUNDAY CRICKET

The necessity to play competition cricket on Sundays was forced upon the association in its endeavours to accommodate all those wishing to engage in our sport. However it is not without its problems - administratively, with the council, grounds, family life and so on.

It is the aim of the executive to eliminate Sunday cricket, or alternatively, to limit it strictly to a few grounds, thus enabling the council to have full use of other areas for public benefit.

ADMINISTRATION

The time of the executive committee was grossly taken up in hearing allegations, charges, etc, made by umpires, both official and otherwise, and by opposing teams and clubs. In the result, several members were suspended, reprimanded or dealt with in other ways. The regularity of this type of problem has caused the executive to take steps in an endeavour to overcome recurrences next season.

At the past two council meetings, clubs have been informed of the association's intentions with regard to duty teams next season, and the proposal will be explained in full at the Annual General Meeting. The executive urges all clubs to support this proposal in the spirit of making cricket in this shire the game it should be.

Regrettably over the past few years, sport, including cricket has undergone a change. In the result, too often are there confront-

ations, allegations and abuse, all leading away from what we as cricketers should expect to gain from our chosen sport. Without a doubt, television close-ups of aggressiveness by prominent sportsmen in action have helped to develop this type of attitude in our players, both young and old. Something had to be done, and the executive has shown the way by bringing forward for trial a scheme which we think will work.

INNOVATIONS

The association abandoned play on the Rugby League grand final day to allow our members the opportunity to support the Sharks. This move was well received in most quarters, though some criticism was levelled at the decision.

White balls will be given a trial during the coming season and each team will be asked to make a report on them. If the reports are favourable, further consideration will be given to the adoption of white balls for future competitions.

LIFE MEMBER

It was most pleasing to witness a long-serving member, Ray Noakes elected to life membership of our association. Ray has given a lot to the game, on the field, administratively and behind the scenes. His prowess at the game and his efforts on behalf of Engadine Dragons are well-known. His contribution to Sutherland Representative cricket has not been equalled. He has been a member of the association executive and his cricket wisdom was of great benefit. Additionally, Ray is a qualified - and when the opportunity arises, an active - Umpire.

Many things were said about Ray Noakes and his unselfish devotion to the game he loves, and his modest response was typical of him. A presentation will be made to him at the Presentation Dinner.

TESTIMONIAL DINNER

The association arranged a testimonial dinner for Jack Edwards who did not offer himself for re-election last year. Jack was a member of our association for almost countless years, and President for no less than thirteen years. Jack and his family were eulogised in glowing terms by cricket associates from several eras. The night was enjoyable and memorable and an inscribed presentation was made by Vince Ridge.

Andrew Hilditch, the success of Sutherland Cricket, was guest speaker. His quite unassuming approach to his limelight and fame was most impressive and he endeared himself to all those present.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Again a strong committee, ably led by Vince Ridge in his first year as president. Congratulations to Vince on an outstanding effort in filling the seat left vacant by the retiring Jack Edwards. All members of the committee pulled their weight, and heavy it is with the numbers that we have registered.

APPRECIATION

Again more than 900 individual mailings of letters were necessary in an effort to maintain good communication among our

cricketing fraternity.

I offer sincere thanks to those club officials, members and particularly secretaries who gave their cooperation and assistance.

COMPETITION

The competition was conducted this season again in twelve grades. As indicated earlier in this report, four teams were defeated in the finals, who had been minor premiers. These teams were:

Sutherland Soccer in A2, Gynea Bay in B3, Grays Point in B7 and Sutherland Soccer in C2.
