PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Ladies and Gentlemen,

Once again we reach that point in time when it is appropriate to cast our minds back and review the achievements and disappointments of the recent cricket season.

Cricket continued its steady growth in the shire under the patronage of the Grade Club, the Men's Association and the Junior Association. There was a further cementing of the relationship between these three bodies, and this was evident in the cooperation on a number of projects throughout the season.

Our own team affiliations increased and competitions were well run, and it appears that the only single factor holding back further expansion will be the shortage of grounds. We have been receiving very sympathetic consideration from council in this regard, and our hope is that it will not be too long before there will be enough grounds to cater for our needs.

The most notable accomplishment from an administrative point of view was the publication of our own book of the laws of the game, incorporating the new 1980 code of M.C.C. laws, NSW Junior Cricket Union amendments to those laws and the by-laws of the Sutherland Shire Cricket Association.

For the first time, cricketers of this association were able to have a single book containing the laws under which they are playing each Saturday, as well as the constitution of the association and the standing orders. This was not the situation previously, and in fact ours is the first association affiliated with the Junior Union to come forward with such a publication. This is a step forward in administration as an adjunct to the Duty Umpiring scheme, to assist players to know the laws governing their game.

Many members of the executive spent long hours on the production of the book and I congratulate them on a magnificent effort. Duty Umpiring entered its second year and it was pleasing to note that the cooperation of the clubs increased, and individual players on the whole are attempting to improve their standard of umpiring. The off-season could be put to good advantage by clubs organising meetings to discuss the laws of the game, using our book and perhaps arranging for a member of the Sutherland Shire Cricket Umpires Association to assist at such a gathering. This is an activity that the Umpires Association keenly fosters.

A surprising aspect this season has been the number of games forfeited in various grades for a variety of reasons. Many complaints were received by the executive, upon the introduction of duty umpiring, about the loss of cricket to members by being forced to umpire on four Saturdays per season. Now we have the situation where teams voluntarily decide not to play cricket because it clashes with some social occasion. It is the duty of club officials to ensure that teams meet their commitments and they may be well advised to be more realistic when accepting registration of players and nominating the

number of teams they can successfully manage.

Following on the spate of suspensions of players found guilty of misconduct over previous seasons, it is very gratifying to observe that a much improved situation prevailed this season. There were only two players suspended this season, however it is disappointing to reveal that both were from our premier grade "A1".

The executive looks to the A1 as the show piece of cricket of our Association, as it normally contains the more gifted players - young men hoping to progress further in the game, experienced players who have enjoyed success at a higher level and cricketers who see A1 as the ultimate in competition in the Association.

This grade should set the standard for all other grades to follow in the brand of cricket played and expertise in all facets of the game, including sportsmanship. It is earnestly hoped that A1 captains and their players will become more aware of their responsibilities to the game of cricket in the Sutherland Shire.

In conclusion I would like to congratulate all competition winners and to thank the runners-up for their efforts. I wish all our members a successful 1981 - 82 season.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

It is most pleasing to report on a successful season - one that provided your executive committee with fewer controversial problems than several seasons in the recent past.

MEMBERSHIP

Season 1980-81 saw the disappearance of six clubs - Caringbah Inn, Cronulla Footballers, Engadine Hotel, Heathcote Juniors, Royal Bulldogs and Sutherland Footballers. Three new clubs were admitted - Davell Ranges, Loftus Rovers and Weronora RSL. Some of the clubs which dropped out amalgamated with other active clubs. The number of affiliated clubs dropped by three to thirty-five. Team entries increased from 89 to 93, played in 13 grades and player registrations dropped by 3 from 1600 to 1597.

GROUNDS

The association obviously accepted too many teams for the number of playing fields available, and the only spare ground was the unsuitable Miranda Park No 1 field. Though the association received notification in writing from the administration of Cronulla Sutherland Leagues Club that Endeavour No 2 field would be available for use, this ground was frequently pulled out of use with little and sometimes no notice, thus making the A1 competition difficult to conduct. Towards the end of the season work commenced on extensions to Boys' Town and consequently one of the four fields there became unavailable. Arrangements have been made to have a new field prepared at Boys' Town, hopefully for the coming season. However, the situation at Endeavour No 2 is such that the executive committee has resolved that it is impossible to allocate that ground on a positive basis, and will not include it in the draw for 1981-82 season.

Two, and perhaps three new wickets are on the drawing board, but not for the coming season. Also discussions have been held, and are continuing, with a school with a view to the construction of a wicket with synthetic topping.

SUTHERLAND SHIRE COUNCIL

Our continuing good relationship with the Sutherland Shire Council and its officers has undoubtedly led to the better running of our association. Once again, Shire Engineer Eric Hirst and Parks and Playgrounds Engineer Brian Baker were most helpful in advising us on ground matters and in programming their essential work so as to be of least interference to our use of the various ovals.

A second synthetic wicket has been constructed at Lilli Pilli Oval. It is hoped that a third will become a reality soon, thus allowing for a complete competition on these wickets.

SPORTS ADMINISTRATION SEMINAR

On Monday 20th July a sports administration seminar was conducted at the Port Hacking Rugby Club by the Department of Sport and Recreation. Maria Long, Regional Director of the Department, arranged the seminar in conjunction with the Rugby Club. Cricket was represented

by David Dee, Monty Perry, Don Clark and myself. The role of government, local government and the local regional office was explained and the areas of assistance available outlined. It is anticipated that a seminar on cricket in our area will soon be conducted, under the auspices of the Department of Sport and Recreation.

GRADING

The grading committee took a hard line in its approach to "hard luck" stories and believes that this attitude helped to keep some of our members honest, or at least more honest than they may have been otherwise.

There is no doubt that the grading committee will continue its attitude towards Clubs, teams and players who endeavour to "put it over" and in this way make the game more enjoyable for all.

FINALS

Good weather saw the completion of all finals games and five minor premiers were defeated.

SELECTION COMMITTEE AND REPRESENTATIVE TEAMS

Once again headed by Committeeman Jim Field, the selectors chose strong representation in the Martin, Telegraph and Durham Shield competitions. The achievements of these teams are recorded elsewhere.

SPORTS ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO SUTHERLAND SHIRE COUNCIL

Again I had the privilege of representing our cricket at these important meetings. I was able to offer cricket's cooperation with other sports, always bearing in mind our own needs. I am happy to report that cricket was not involved in any of the controversies that occurred between the various sports represented at these gatherings.

STANDARDIZATION OF BALLS

This innovation has been an outstanding success, resulting in huge savings for most clubs. On advice from the association's final council meeting, the Steeden ball will again be used in 1981-82.

Also, a sponsorship arrangement has been entered into with Charlie's Sports and Toys Centre, Gynea Bay Road, Gynea.

RULES

It was satisfying to have the association constitution, rules and by-laws, together with the laws of cricket, printed in the one publication and made available to all teams early in the season. This advancement has assisted all cricketers and has been of invaluable help in reducing the inquiries about details of rules and playing laws.

DUTY TEAMS

The duty team system has been accepted by most cricketers in the knowledge that it affords a fair go to all and last season allowed the association to accept 13 teams which otherwise would have been rejected through lack of grounds. The executive committee has been grateful to receive commendations of the scheme from those who previously were anti or undecided. Further, the system has been adopted by associations in other areas and by administrators of other sports.

ADMINISTRATION

Some clubs are badly administered, thus causing problems for the executive committee and reducing the pleasure and benefit that players get from our game. It is a fact of life that because of insufficient playing fields the number of teams to be accepted for 1981-82 season will be fewer than for last season. The executive has discussed various ways of applying different criteria to decide how this end will be achieved.

Fines were imposed on several clubs for various matters, the most severe penalty being the suspension of an A1 player until 31 March 1982.

LIFE MEMBER

The final council meeting for the 1980-81 season unanimously bestowed life membership upon the association treasurer, Martin Taylor.

Martin's activities on the cricket field and as an administrator are well known to most cricketers in the shire. He is devoted to the game, and has been described as a cricket fanatic.

As a youngster Martin played cricket in the street and at school. He was a member of several Heathcote boys' teams and joined the SSCA competition as a member of that club in 1950-51. He has played every season since then.

Martin played with Heathcote until 1953-54 when he transferred to the newly formed Southern United club. He enjoyed his cricket in various grades and in 1963-64 was elected secretary of Southern United and that club's delegate to the association. He remained secretary of Southern United until the club disbanded at the end of 1974-75. He joined Sylvania Heights in 1975-76 and is still turning out for them.

In 1973-74 season Martin was elected to the association's executive committee and undertook several responsible tasks, always displaying his methodical effective approach to his undertakings. He was promoted to association treasurer in 1977-78 and has performed his duties in this onerous and demanding office with cold efficiency, bringing to the association's coffers all outstanding money in record time.

Contributions by Martin to executive committee deliberations and decisions are valued. He is short in words, precise and to the point - trends which may be misinterpreted by those who do not know him well as unfriendliness. The fact is that Martin is most helpful and friendly though he does not tolerate fools, or those who pretend, lightly.

Martin Taylor has displayed prowess at our game particularly in batting and wicketkeeping. He has captained his team and led his players by example. He is heartily putting something back into the game through his time-consuming efforts as an administrator and is truly deserving of the honour of life membership now given to him.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

A strong committee whose members made firm and positive decisions in the overall interests of cricket as we know it.

TROPHIES

Three trophies are as yet unsponsored and unnamed, despite offers made at early season meetings last year.
