PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Members of the Sutherland Shire Cricket Association,

We have again reached that time when we look back and review the happenings of the past season.

From an administrative point of view, it has been a most successful season, with very few problems. We found this to be a pleasant change from previous seasons, and indeed there was only one occasion when it was necessary to enquire into player misconduct. This is a good sign, and it is to be hoped that this trend continues in the future.

We were fortunate in experiencing very few disturbances to our pattern of cricket because of ground shortages, although this aspect does continue to remain our most vexing problem. However, we enjoy the utmost co-operation of the Sutherland Shire Council and its officers, who fully recognise our difficulties, and are endeavouring to increase the number of fields available for cricket. As for the coming season, it is still going to be tight in regard to acceptance of more teams into the competition.

The Executive plans to reprint the Rule Book, and incorporate some necessary changes to both the constitution and the laws. The booklet this time however will be a pocket version and will be easier to carry. This task should be completed by the end of the year.

It was with deep regret that we learned of the passing of our life member and former Junior Vice-President, Ray Noakes, in May. Ray was a fine cricketer, and a credit to the game. In his latter years he became a thoughtful administrator who brought experience and common sense to the discussion table. Those who came into close contact with him could not fail to be impressed by the way he lived, worked and played sport. He was a fine example for the young to follow, and all of us are the poorer for his passing.

Finally, I would like to commend the whole Executive for their attention to duty and thank them on your behalf for their unselfish efforts in promoting cricket.

In conclusion, let me congratulate the Premier teams and the individual trophy winners. Commiserations to the runners-up. I fully appreciate the feelings of those who came in second.

I wish all members a successful season in 1982 - 83.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Again it is my pleasure to report on a successful season - 1981 - 82. In reviewing the past twelve months the most grievous task is that of mentioning the sad passing of two fine gentlemen - Ray Noakes and Alan Ward. I have written valedictories about both and they appear elsewhere in this report.

MEMBERSHIP

Two clubs - Caringbah Bowlers and Illawong - did not affiliate and a new club, St John Bosco was admitted, making a total of 34 clubs. Team entries dropped from 93 to 84 and player registrations dropped from 1597 to 1444.

GROUNDS

The shortage of playing fields forced the executive committee to discourage clubs and teams from building up their numbers. Miranda Park is no longer available for men's cricket and the Boys' Town area has been effectively reduced to only two fields. New fields are in the course of preparation, but there will not be enough to accommodate the teams wishing to participate. At the most recent delegates' meeting the clubs of the 1981-82 season indicated that they wished to nominate an extra 14 teams. Additionally, three new clubs each wish to enter two teams, making a total increase of twenty teams. It is unlikely that the Association will be able to accept any of these extra teams into a competition structure as we now know it. The hard facts make the answer simple - there are insufficient grounds to do so.

Inquiries have been made about various types of synthetic toppings for cricket pitches. It is the intention that more of these wickets be installed.

SUTHERLAND SHIRE COUNCIL

Our continuing good relationship with the council and its officers has greatly assisted in the smooth running of our association. Shire Engineer, Eric Hirst and Parks and Playgrounds Engineer, Brian Baker have offered helpful advice on ground matters and they and their fellow workers at the council have willingly co-operated with us and other cricketing bodies in the Shire.

GRADING

The attitude of the grading committee remained firm and consequently players with real cricketing ability who were lingering in the lower grades were promoted to a more suitable competition for their skills. The committee grades each team submitted to it on what it regards as the best six players included in the team affiliation form, and in this way endeavours to have fairly even competitions. Regrettably, and this seems to involve the same few clubs each year, as soon as the team gradings were announced, several late registrations were submitted for inclusion in teams which otherwise would have been graded in a higher competition. The committee had no alternative but to reject the players, who consequently had to affiliate with another club or miss out on a season's cricket.

SELECTION COMMITTEES AND REPRESENTATIVE TEAMS

Once again headed by Jim Field the selectors chose strong teams for the Martin, Telegraph and Durham Shields. The achievements of these teams are recorded elsewhere in this report. Congratulations to David Gibbs who took out the Batting Aggregate in the Telegraph Shield competition.

RULE BOOKS

A sponsorship arrangement relating to balls has been renegotiated with Charlie's Sports and Toys Centre, Gynea Bay Road, Gynea, which will provide funds for the printing of a pocket size rule book, fully amended. It is expected that this will be available for the second half of the season.

ADMINISTRATION

It is most pleasing to report that with few exceptions, clubs in 1981-82 were efficiently administered and cooperated fully with the Executive Committee. No doubt this has evolved from the tight situation in grounds and the obvious necessity for club members to be aware of what is happening in the local cricket scene. Team affiliations not received by the date agreed to and published were not accepted, with the result that several teams missed out.

Though the committee dealt with several "judiciary" matters, none were of major import. Nevertheless, Vince Ridge and I have had to have several discussions with a legal firm relating to previous matters and to ensure that Association and Club officials are protected against possible action.

LIFE MEMBER

Life membership was unanimously conferred upon Jim Field by the final council meeting of the 1981-82 season.

Jim has been a selector of Association representative teams since the early 1970's and for the past few years a dependable and reliable member of the Executive Committee, most recently occupying the position of Vice-President.

His "father figure" image is borne out in his mature and steady thinking on executive matters. He holds his peace until he has something worthwhile to say and states his view independently. Jim has very firm views on how cricket should be played and administered.

Jim Field began his career as a boy with South Hurstville Cricket Club. In 1940 he played interdistrict boys' cricket and the following year played with St George 2nd Grade. He served with the armed forces between 1941 and 1945, returning to cricket in 1946 with Brighton Juniors in the St George A Grade competition. During this period he won many individual trophies, including the bowling average and aggregate in 1959-60.

Subsequently Jim moved to the Sutherland Shire and joined up with Sylvania Heights Youth Club. As the guiding force behind the entry of that club into senior cricket, Jim had the honour of captaining their original side. He has since led Youth Club sides almost every year, including two seasons when they were runners-up in A1 grade.

Jim recently announced his retirement from active playing. This retirement lasted until the new cricket season, when he turned out in the B1 grade and again performed creditably with both bat and ball.

Jim's best playing years were before he came to us. His record shows that during the 1940's he played in excellent company with the St George Grade Club. His best effort with the bat appears to have been with an army representative side in Darwin where he topscored with 163. Obviously Jim could have played more grade cricket than he did, but he chose to guide young players along what he considered to be proper lines.

Jim has worked hard for Sylvania Heights Youth Club as a long-serving committee member, and in 1977 he was rewarded with Life Membership of his club. His interest in administration of Sylvania Heights Youth was probably strengthened by his wife Val being Secretary of the cricket activity for some time.

Jim Field is a true supporter of cricket and our association. He has always been willing to assist in any extra undertaking in which the association might be involved, making the task easier for others. Jim has always done the right thing and I considered it an honour to have been his nominator for life membership of the Association.

COMPETITION

The competition was conducted in 12 grades, each of 7 teams. Finals were played in all grades and the results were:

- B6 Sylvania Heights Youth defeated Engadine Dragons (Minor Premiers)
- B7 St Patrick's defeated Caringbah DLS (Minor Premiers)
- C1 Sutherland Soccer defeated St Patrick's
- C2 Jannali defeated Caringbah Sports (Minor Premiers)

As indicated, four Minor Premiers were defeated in the finals. Congratulations to all the winning teams.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Again a strong committee whose members were called upon to make firm and positive decisions in the best interests of cricket.

SILVER ANNIVERSARY OF BOYS' ASSOCIATION

The executive committee and members of the Sutherland Shire Cricket Association congratulate the Sutherland Shire Junior Cricket Association on achieving the milestone of twenty-five years of offering cricket to the youngsters of the Shire.

The contribution of the "Boys' Association", as it was known for most of these years, to the development of cricket in the Sutherland area is well known and acknowledged. The "Senior Association" has enjoyed the benefit of accommodating players who have emerged from the ranks of the juniors, but it is the Sutherland Grade Club that has had most opportunity to prosper from the training and disciplining that your body has given to boys in their formative cricketing years.

The fraternity that exists between our two associations is most gratifying to administrators of both organisations. It is intended that these good relations should continue for the next twenty-five years and beyond, in the interests of our chosen sport.

The 25 not out is something to be proud of, especially in the knowledge that that score will undoubtedly grow higher.

Vale... Ray Noakes

Ray Noakes, or Noaksey, as we all knew him, was a good bloke! His untimely passing left a gap in many places, not the least of which was cricket.

Ray earned his life membership of the Sutherland Shire Cricket Association by a positive contribution to the game and to its administration.

Perhaps a reproduction of what was published by his own club, Engadine Dragons, gives the best insight into this man, who was our true friend.

"It is with the deepest possible sadness we record the death on 14th May, 1982 of our dear friend and comrade, Ray Noakes.

Ray was a fully active member of our club for many years, being President for three years, Vice-President, Senior Club Champion, Delegate to the Association and Boys' Coach. He was awarded Life Membership for his work for our club.

He was also Vice-President of the Sutherland Shire Cricket Association and for his work for cricket generally in the Shire he was awarded Life Membership of that Association.

Ray was also for many years a member of the Cricket Umpires' Association and prior to the formation of our club, was on the committee of the Engadine Dragons Sports Club.

In his younger days he played grade cricket and baseball with the St George Club.

Yes, Ray Noakes was a fine sportsman.

But he was more than just that - Ray Noakes was a very special man. All who came in contact with him could not help but be impressed by his attitude to sport and to life in general. Not for Ray the noisy showy way of doing things, just a quiet, dignified, modest approach to all he did, be it on the field or off.

He was the ultimate sportsman, never querying a bad decision that went against him. He always accepted the umpire's decision.

Ray also had great courage. This was never more evident than in his battle against illness, for he was never heard to complain or ask "hy me?" Again, he accepted the Umpire's decision.

Ray has left a legacy that will live for many years. Many boys playing for our club got their start with Ray. There was no better introduction to cricket, both in learning the fundamentals of the game and in learning the correct attitude.

To perpetuate Ray's memory, we are establishing a cricket coaching scholarship scheme whereby each year boys, not only with outstanding potential as players, but also of a character that reflects Ray's image, will be selected to attend special coaching courses conducted by a suitable organisation. Further details will be announced later.

We who knew Ray are much richer for that experience - we are poorer for his passing.

How lucky are his wife, Vi, with whom he shared a unique relationship, sons, Peter and Mark and daughter, Julie, to have shared their lives with such a real man."

Vale... Alan Ward, O.A.M.

No one more than Alan Ward, as Secretary of the New South Wales Junior Cricket Union helped the Sutherland Shire Cricket Association in administrative, playing and practical matters affecting our senior body.

Alan dedicated his life to community work from which others gained benefit. He died suddenly and unexpectedly in April and his cricketing shoes will be hard to fill.

Alan, besides being Secretary of the Junior Union since 1967, held many other positions. He was:

Delegate to the NSW Cricket Association
Secretary of the Australian Council of Cricket Unions for 10 years
A member of the Country Committee of the NSMCA
NSW delegate to the National Youth Council of the Australian Cricket Board
Secretary of the Northern Suburbs Cricket Association from 1956 - 1973 and President from 1974
An active member of that Association for 31 years holding various offices
An active umpire, umpiring in 1st grade, Sheffield Shield, McDonald's cup and international matches
A member of the NSW Cricket Umpires' Association executive
A Life Member of the Junior Union and Northern Suburbs Cricket Association
Awarded the O.A.M. (Order of Australia Medal) for services to cricket in 1981.

As well as all his cricket activities, he found time to be an active member of the Willoughby Musical Society for 25 years - being one of the foundation members.

Our Association will forever be indebted to Alan for his assistance. Cricket is the poorer for Alan's passing.

SUTHERLAND SHIRE JUNIOR CRICKET ASSOCIATION

This year the Junior Association had a total of 1624 boys playing in age groups from under 10 to under 16 years, a total of 126 teams entered in the competitions run. There was only one final in one grade, but most of the Premiers were not known until the conclusion of the last round.

Our association entered the Shell representative competitions with two 10's, two 12's and two 14's plus one 16 year team. We were finalists in the 12, 14 and 16 year competitions with the 10's missing out on making their final by less than one run. We were successful in retaining the Under 12 Shield, but lost the 14's and 16's, both of which we had held last year as well as the Under 12 Shield.

This year being our 25th Anniversary, our Annual Report will be a special edition including highlights of these 25 years. There will be reports on our "Cricketers of the Year" during this time with a history of what they have achieved in life since then as well as a history of clubs which have played in this Association. Included also will be the names of every boy who played cricket this year and every boy should receive a copy of this report.

I would like to congratulate the Men's Association on a successful year, and in attending their meetings I have found that good rapport exists between us which only convinces me that when our boys leave us they are going into an association that will cater well for them and enable them to enjoy their cricket as they grow older.

May 1982-83 bring more enjoyment to you all in your cricket.
