PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Ladies and Gentlemen,

Once again I take pleasure in reporting that the Association has concluded a most successful season.

Due to the efforts of the Executive and the cooperation and support of you, the members, we are financially sound and are providing high quality competitive cricket for eighty-seven teams comprising nearly fourteen hundred members.

The meetings of the Association have been well attended by the delegates and the standard of debate indicates that a keen interest is taken in Association affairs.

Our representative teams met with mixed success this season because of the uncertain weather, however we were well represented by these young men. The Martin Shield team could fairly claim they experienced poor luck, losing only one match during the series when they lost the toss and were caught on a wet wicket. This side also created a record by toppling the Grade Club all age side in the Rex King trophy matches.

I would like to convey my congratulations to the Premiers in all grades and the individual trophy winners whilst commiserating with the losers in the finals.

Also I thank the Umpires' Association for their cooperation during the season which provided some heartburn for both organisations. I am sure that we now have stronger bonds linking us for the good of cricket.

The printing of the new rule book, which was promised last season, was unfortunately held up because of administrative problems; we hope that it will be available by the start of this coming season.

Two requests I make of clubs this year are (1) to ensure that a real effort is made to upgrade the standard of dress of duty umpires and (2) to conduct in-team discussions on the LBW law before taking your turn at Duty Umpiring. These two points are still the most disappointing aspect of our scheme.

Finally, my thanks to the Executive for their untiring efforts, and best wishes to all members for the coming season.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Our Association has seen yet another successful season during 1982 - 83. Team entries rose from 84 to 89 and player registrations remained static at 1437, compared with the previous season.

GROUNDS

The shortage of playing fields again forced the executive committee to discourage clubs and teams from building up their numbers. One new field, a synthetic wicket at Port Hacking Rugby Club, became available, and this together with tight administration and the cooperative attitude of association members allowed the acceptance of a few extra teams over last season. Already inquiries have been made by two new clubs wishing to enter these teams and extra teams from existing clubs have also been mooted. It is unlikely that the association will be able to accept any extra teams into a competition structure as we now know it. There will be no extra grounds this year!

SUTHERLAND SHIRE COUNCIL

Our continuing good relationship with the council and its officers has greatly assisted in the smooth running of the association. Shire Engineer, Eric Hirst, and Parks and Playgrounds Engineer, Brian Baker, have again offered and provided helpful advice on ground matters. Council officers, Eugene Morris, Denis Walker, Bill Nakkan, John Comerford and Colleen Stahlut have also willingly cooperated with us and the other cricketing bodies in the Shire.

GRADING

The grading committee maintained a firm approach to its task and many players who have demonstrated a real ability in cricket were "discovered" from their hideaways in the lower grades and arbitrarily promoted to a grade more realistically in accord with their skills. Some players of this type still linger in the lower grades as is revealed by the scoresheets submitted at the end of the season. Your grading committee aims to continue to flush out these players by promoting them within their own club or declaring them ineligible to play with a particular team. The policy of the committee is to grade each team on the best six players nominated on the affiliation form, and it regards this method as the best to obtain even competitions. Regrettably, the committee had no alternative but to reject the registration application of several players who were late nominations for teams already graded. These players were invited to register with another club which offered teams in higher grades.

REPRESENTATIVE TEAMS

Chairman of Selectors, Jim Field, arranged for selection and trials of Martin, Daily Telegraph and Durham Shield teams in a fashion likened to a well-oiled machine. The teams comprised good cricketers who were also good blokes, but collectively they were the unluckiest bunch of players competing in the Shield matches. However, that is the game of cricket.

ADMINISTRATION

Only four clubs might be termed as badly administered, and appropriate notice has been given to them to get their act together and so avoid problems for themselves and the association, as well as eliminating forfeits, which are always a disappointment to all concerned.

Disciplinary matters were at an all-time low, and this is most pleasing to report. Nevertheless, Vince Ridge, David Dee and I are still working, in conjunction with legal advice, on the production of rules which will offer proper protection to the association, the committee and individual members. Regrettably, this is necessary as a result of local occurrences in recent years.

COMPETITION

The competition was conducted in thirteen grades. Finals were played in all grades and the results were:
