PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Ladies and Gentlemen,

I would like to extend my congratulations to all members for a successful 1983-84 season which once again established that this Association is providing quality cricket for the enjoyment of players of all ages.

It was indeed a pity that after most of the competitions had been so closely contested throughout the summer, rain should mar the finals by washing out the first day's play. There was some consolation on the second day, which turned out fine and sunny, when all finalists were able to take the field. Of the thirteen finals, first innings results were achieved in two, while the other eleven resulted in draws. In all cases the Minor Premiers went on to be declared Premiers.

In an effort to give more opportunity for a result if similar conditions occur in the future, the delegates at the June Rules Meeting voted to amend the rules for finals. In future, if the first day's play is abandoned, then six hours play will be allowed on the second day, but with no sharing of time. Play will commence at 10:00am with a lunch break between 1:00 pm and 1:45 pm. At the same meeting it was decided to reduce the points awarded to Duty teams for carrying out their Umpiring duties from ten to six points.

I have promised in my last two Presidential Messages that our new Rule Book would be published, and it is very gratifying for me to announce at long last, that the work has been completed, the books have been printed and each team will receive three copies free of charge at the August Delegates meeting. For the enormous amount of work that has been involved in producing this publication I would like to thank Col McElroy, President of the Umpires' Association and our own David Dee and Bob Davey for their efforts.

It is with regret that I report the passing, in June of Mrs Wyn Wakely, the widow of one of our finest cricketers of past years, Bill Wakely. Wyn was a staunch supporter of the Association and we extend to her family our deepest sympathy.

In conclusion, let me thank our Executive for their untiring efforts in organising cricket for the Association and also commend you members for the cooperation you have given to us.

My best wishes to all for the 1984-85 season.

LIFE MEMBER

Trevor Jones, current member of the Sutherland Shire Cricket Umpires Association and a long standing member of our Association was elevated to life membership at the final council meeting for the 1983 - 84 season.

Trevor's activities on the cricket field both as a player and later as an umpire, and his contribution as an administrator would be well known to most cricketers in the Shire.

He was a born country boy, but moved to Newtown while still very young and eventually his family settled in the Sutherland Shire where at the age of ten his cricket career began. He first played with the old Engadine Sports Club and moved through the age group competition until at fifteen he was selected in the first C.S. Watson Shield team to represent the Shire.

For the next few years Trevor played in the Western Suburbs competition, but returned to the Shire cricket scene in 1963 with the Engadine Hotel side. This side enjoyed great success in the early 1960's and when it disbanded to reform as Engadine Dragons, Trevor joined the Sutherland School of Arts Club.

However the urge to play with his home suburb influenced Trevor to join the Dragons in 1968 and this began a long association which has seen Trevor serving on their executive committee in various positions. During this time he was an important member of the A1 side which went on to win a number of premierships. It was from this team that he was selected to represent the Association in the Martin Shield side where he performed with distinction for several seasons.

As a cricketer Trevor was a hard-hitting aggressive batsman, a strong fielder and an intelligent medium pace bowler. He applied himself by being a deep thinker about the game.

In 1973 while still a playing member of Dragons' A1 team, he decided to expand his career by becoming an umpire. In 1975 he took on these duties on a full-time basis. He is now considered to be one of the best umpires that this Shire has produced.

During the 1982 - 83 season he ventured back onto the playing arena briefly to help the newly formed Loftus Cricket Club while still carrying out official umpiring duties whenever he could.

Trevor moved through the ranks of the Umpires Association occupying a number of positions until in 1976 he was elected to the Presidency of that body. It was in this role that he served on our Association Executive Committee and brought to the meetings his special style of frankness and his commonsense approach. He is a man of integrity who has certainly given much of himself back to the game of cricket.

Throughout his career Trevor has enjoyed the active support of his wife, Sheila and of their children, and in awarding the richly deserved honour of Life Membership of our Association, we pay due recognition to their efforts and sacrifices.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

It is pleasing to report on yet another successful season during 1983 - 84. Team entries remained the same at 89, while player registrations numbered 1489, an increase of 52 on the 1982 - 83 season.

GROUNDS

The continuing shortage of playing fields forced the executive committee to restrict the competition to 89 teams and to discourage clubs and teams from building up their numbers. Another synthetic wicket was laid at Gwawley West and a new ground at Bangor became available although its size restricts its use. Inquiries have been made by clubs wishing to enter more teams and two new clubs have indicated their desire to join the Association - one of them wishing to nominate four teams. It is unlikely that the Association will be able to accept extra teams next season. Vacancies will only be available as teams or clubs disband. However, as extra grounds become available, additional teams will be accepted. There are no extra grounds planned for this year.

SUTHERLAND SHIRE COUNCIL

The smooth running of the Association is greatly assisted by our continuing good relationship with the council and its officers. Shire Engineer Eric Hirst and Parks and Playgrounds Engineer Brian Baker have been most helpful on ground matters. We continue to get willing cooperation from Council officers Eugene Morris, Denis Walker, Bill Nakkan, Colleen Stahlut and Fat Thew. Our thanks to them for their assistance.

GRADING

The vigilance of the grading committee over the past few seasons has resulted in the competitions becoming closer and players being graded more realistically. Only a few instances of players being too good for a grade occurred this year and the Executive Committee is pleased to see clubs cooperating in this regard. However, there were still a few players who had to be promoted by the committee during the year and clubs are reminded that the committee considers unrealistic grading as an unfair practice.

The policy of the committee is to grade each team on the best six players nominated on the affiliation form and adherence to this policy has produced fair competitions. Late applications for registration regrettably must be rejected when it is felt that these may appreciably affect the grading of a team.

REPRESENTATIVE TEAMS

Teams were entered in the Martin, Daily Telegraph and Durham Shield competitions and a detailed report of their performances appears later in this booklet. This year the weather severely interrupted the competitions and unfortunately this was to our disadvantage. Congratulations to all players on being selected to represent the Shire and to the award winners :- Martin Shield - Greg Tampion, Daily Telegraph - Chris Allen and Durham - Peter Fallins.

Our thanks also to the selection panel, Rick Francis, Steve Harding and chairman Ron Arnold for their efforts.

ADMINISTRATION

Regrettably, two clubs in our Association are badly administered and they have been notified that their affiliation for next season is in jeopardy. This is unfortunate for the players in these clubs, but we see no reason why other clubs should be "mucked around" by clubs which appear disinterested in cooperating to provide good cricket. Perhaps the new clubs which have requested consideration for affiliation will provide more suitable administration.

The Rule book promised for so long has been published and will be issued during August, prior to the commencement of the new season. Our thanks to all concerned in the production of this vital document.

ADMINISTRATION (continued)

Clubs are reminded of the importance of providing up-to-date addresses of their Secretaries for purposes of effective communication. Please check the list printed elsewhere in this Report and notify Bob Davey of any alterations. Names of Team Captains are also to be included on Team Affiliation forms as contact needs sometimes to be made directly with them in emergencies or as last season when a "Letter to Captains" replaced the customary Captains Meeting. This proved popular with team captains and is likely to be tried again next season.

COMPETITION

The competition was conducted in thirteen grades. Finals were played in all grades but because the first day's play was washed out, wins were gained in only two grades.
