PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Ladies and Gentlemen,

The 1984-85 season has come to a successful conclusion and I extend my congratulations to the Premiership winning teams and the individual trophy winners. Commiserations to the teams who were unsuccessful but I do hope that they can take heart from the fact that they played their best during the season.

One disappointing aspect to come out of the finals was that in some matches time wasting tactics were carried out beyond the bounds of good sportsmanship. It is certainly part of cricket that slowing down the game is a legitimate tactic. However, it must be done within the laws. The umpires play their part by endeavouring to keep the game moving but they are limited in the action they can take on the day.

The Executive have discussed the matter and will recommend at the Annual General Meeting a change in the rules for Finals, viz that a minimum of sixty overs be bowled if a team bats the full time on either day.

Midway through the season we were unfortunate to lose the services of our Senior Vice President, Rick Walker who moved to the North Coast. Rick represented the association with distinction as our delegate to the District Club and the Umpires Association. We are the poorer for losing his expertise as an administrator but wish him well for the future.

Finally I take this opportunity to thank all of the Executive for their dedication and skills in administering our game. To all members, thank you for your cooperation and best wishes for the coming season.

## SECRETARY'S REPORT

Our Association has seen yet another successful season during 1984 - 85. The number of teams accommodated was 87, a drop of two from last season, involving 1501 players. There are now 40,000 players registered with the NSW Junior Cricket Union, playing in 2663 teams.

### GROUNDS

Once again the shortage of grounds forced the Executive to discourage clubs from building up their numbers. Already seven new teams from three new clubs have requested affiliation in 1985 - 86. The new approval by the Sutherland Shire Council to overcome its ground maintenance and preparation problems will shorten the cricket season by several weeks, starting later in September and finishing half-way through March. Fortunately, negotiations with the Council seem to have resulted in approval to play finals, on a restricted number of agreed grounds, after the cut-off date. There will not be any new grounds this year.

### SUTHERLAND SHIRE COUNCIL

Our continued good relationships with the Council and its officers has greatly assisted in the smooth running of the association. Shire Engineer Eric Hirst and Parks and Playgrounds Engineer Brian Baker have again been most supportive. Council officers Denis Walker, Eugene Morris, Patricia Thew and Colleen Stahlut have also willingly cooperated with us and the other cricketing bodies in the shire.

### GRADING

The maintenance of a firm approach to grading by the grading committee over the past few seasons has resulted in the competitions becoming closer and players being graded realistically. The "crook back, can't bowl" syndrome that used to accompany many applications for registration has disappeared, no doubt as a result of the deaf ear shown to this request for lower gradings by the committee.

The policy of the committee is to grade each team on the best six players nominated on the affiliation form and adherence to this policy has produced fair competitions. Late applications for registration regrettably must be rejected when it is felt that these may appreciably affect the grading of a team.

### REPRESENTATIVE TEAMS

Again teams were entered in the Martin, Telegraph and Durham Shield competitions. Details of their performances in the matches appear later in this booklet. Congratulations to all representative players and to the award winners: - Martin Shield - John Walker, - Daily Telegraph Shield - Wayne Walters, and Durham Shield - Col Grimble.

Chairman of Selectors, Ron Arnold and his co-selectors Rick Francis and Steve Harding again did well in organising strong representation for our association.

### ADMINISTRATION

Again it is regrettable to report that several clubs are so badly administered that continued acceptance of their application for affiliation by the Executive Committee must be in doubt.

It is indeed sad to report that one of our longest affiliated clubs admitted to ringing in a player. The Captain of the team was suspended and the club fined and warned sternly. The ring-in could not be dealt with as he was not a registered player.

Disciplinary matters are still at a low level, again reflecting the non-tolerance of misbehaviour by the Executive Committee. This is most gratifying and results in a more pleasant game for all.

## ADMINISTRATION (continued)

Following the enactment of the Incorporation of Associations Act our association has instructed solicitors to proceed to incorporation. This move, although costly, is in line with an association council decision, and will undoubtedly, allow people who are presently unwilling to offer themselves for office, to reconsider their position. With incorporation there will be protection for Association officials who will not again have to suffer solicitors' letters, telephone calls and threats of court action in relation to the administration of association affairs.

SUTHERLAND SHIRE JUNIOR CRICKET ASSOCIATION REPORT

Again we entered two teams in each of the four competitions.
