A Message from the President

Ladies and Gentlemen,

We have concluded a very successful season and congratulations are extended to the competition premiers and the individual trophy winners.

The season commenced with poor weather conditions prevailing in the early matches and then the sun came out and stayed until the last match of the competition which was interrupted by rain. However the finals were blessed with beautiful sunny days enabling the season to end on a high note.

A disturbing feature of the season was the number of forfeits by teams, particularly at the beginning of the competition. All six teams involved were summoned to appear before the Executive and after comprehensive hearings four of them incurred additional penalties beyond the normal forfeit provisions. It should be clearly borne in mind by club executives that the Association is concerned with providing strong competition for members who want to participate in something more than just a social game of cricket. If players are not prepared to make themselves available for most of the matches and take their turn at duty umpiring, then you are foolish to accept them into your club.

We have had to hold our team affiliations down over the past years because of the shortage of grounds. By so doing we have refused applications from existing teams to increase their number of teams and new clubs wishing to join our competition. It is therefore a ridiculous situation to find teams which have been accepted in good faith not honouring their obligations by competing in all the matches. Those teams/clubs who were involved in forfeits or who did not fully carry out their duty umpiring last season should not feel secure about gaining affiliation next season.

The Association has to be prepared to provide cricket for the growing area of Bangor, Menai and Illawong as well as for established areas of the Shire. At this stage, however, we have only one field in this area. A recent decision of Council to allocate the new Solander fields to Softball coupled with the loss of Shell Point leaves us still short of grounds for the coming season, and the solution to this problem is far from simple.

The one sadness of the season was the passing of Martin Daly (27 years of age) of the Cronulla RSL Cricket Club. Martin was a fine young man, an enthusiastic cricketer and a valued member of the cricket fraternity. To his family we offer our condolences.

Finally I would like to thank all members of the Executive for their hard work throughout the season and their courage, for they had a number of difficult decisions to make.

I wish all members the best for 1986 - 87.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Season 1985 - 86 saw 1451 registered players compete in 87 teams and 13 grades. Though Sutherland is a large association, it would be much bigger if more grounds were available. The coming season will see a reduction of at least three grounds, with no new grounds, which will force a reduction in our team and player numbers.

The Association's continuing good relationship with Council and its officers has ensured a continuation of smooth running. The association executive members have always adopted a straightforward honest approach to dealings with council, and have steadfastly adhered to agreements entered into, as have council officers. This has engendered an atmosphere of confidence among all concerned.

Representative teams were entered in The New South Wales Junior Union Martin, Daily Telegraph and Durham Shield competitions. Details of their respective performances appear elsewhere in this book. Congratulations to all representative players, and particularly to award winners: Martin Shield, Michael Earl; Telegraph Shield, Greg Thomas and Durham Shield, David Ferritt. The selectors, under the chairmanship and guidance of the experienced Jim Field, did a competent job of organising the Association's front line teams.

Firm application of the grading rules again resulted in most of the competitions being tight. The grading committee, with its wide and long experience, is able to eliminate most problems that would otherwise occur through attempts to build up the strength of teams after initial grading.

Administration of clubs during 1985 - 86 was good, though a disturbing number of forfeits occurred, particularly in the early part of the season. With the reduction of available playing fields this year and a corresponding reduction in the number of teams accepted for affiliation, members of clubs/teams that offended by forfeiting would be well advised to consider an alternative activity for the 1986 - 87 cricket season.

Disciplinary matters were not frequently before the committee but regrettably one serious allegation was reported, resulting in severe action by way of suspension.

Incorporation of our Association is underway with only the finalisation of minor details yet to be completed.
