It is sad to record that during last season Norm Coleman of the Port Hacking Rugby Cricket Club and Ken Jennings, an ex-member of Caringbah Sports passed away. Norm had a long fight with his illness and continued to play until early last season. He was a stalwart of the Rugby Club and did more than his share to further the game of cricket in this Shire. Ken Jennings was a fine left hand slow medium bowler and an ideal ambassador for the game at grade level and in our association. Both of these men showed great determination and courage during the course of their illnesses. It was my pleasure to have played with and against both of them over the years and I will carry fond memories of Norm and Ken. To their families we extend our sincere sympathy.

Finally, Ladies and Gentlemen, we are still having problems with our duty umpiring system in that players are not accepting decisions in the true spirit of the game and some duty umpires not making themselves conversant with the laws of the game or performing in a careless fashion. The executive exhorts players and umpires to lift their standards in the coming season.

In conclusion I would like to thank the executive for their efforts during the past season and wish all members every success in the coming one.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Season 1986 - 87 saw little change in our numerical strength, with 1429 players competing in 82 teams representing 30 clubs in 12 grades.

The shortening of the playing season, along with the shortage of grounds, has caused difficulties but with the cooperation and continuing help of the Sutherland Shire Council, particularly Brian Baker and Suzanne Judge, the situation has been alleviated. The trust and confidence placed by the council in the association's executive committee in the use of wet fields are most gratifying and a privilege not afforded to other sports.

Representative teams kept Sutherland's name high in the Martin, Daily Telegraph and Durham Shield competitions. Details are included elsewhere in this report.

Irresponsible grading by a few clubs, or perhaps individuals on behalf of those clubs, caused the grading committee extreme trouble both prior to and during the season. Apparently, even in cricket, integrity means little when there is an opportunity to win. It is disappointing to those who have a real love of the game and who know the way that it should be played for the enjoyment of all.

While on a sour note, it must be said that some clubs were very poorly administered during the past season, resulting in forfeits, non-response to executive communications and requirements and other acts of non-interest. In a couple of cases the executive invited club committees to meet with it and discuss their particular problems. The executive committee is at a complete loss to understand why persons who are not interested are elected to and accept positions in clubs, which inevitably leads to a dropping in the level of potential enjoyment for club members, and on occasions, the downfall of the club.

On a somewhat happier note, there was no occasion for serious disciplinary action to be taken, although the committee is concerned at the attitude adopted by some players towards umpires, both Duty and Official.

Incorporation of the association was commenced, but postponed to await the result of negotiations involving the New South Wales Cricket Association and the New South Wales Junior Union. As no finality has been arrived at, the committee has rekindled its move in this direction and the matter is now in the hands of our solicitors for finalisation.

VALE NORM COLEMAN, M.B.E.

Sadly, in that usually happy period between Christmas and New Year, Norm Coleman died. Norm was the founder and organizer of the Port Hacking Rugby Cricket Club's three teams. He started up this club some years ago "to keep the Pa-Pa's together in the summer", but coincidentally, his actions also brought him back to the game.

Norm played cricket at all levels - grade, representative shield, association and social. He enjoyed it all. His enthusiasm was unbounded, and he succeeded as a player and an administrator. He had an enviable memory of cricket details, both big time and local. He knew the results of all matches in which his clubs teams played and if the paper printed results that did not live up with Norm's figures he would be on the phone to inquire.

Norm Coleman became a successful businessman but he had humble beginnings. His early life was hard and uncertain. As a lad he collected and sold bottles and old newspapers. An accountancy scholarship which he won at school introduced him to a career in which he excelled. He was honorary auditor to many sports and other clubs. His advice was sought and acted upon. Norm's favourable terms, "What about ..." and "The thing is ...", were well known to those who had close dealings with him in community organizations, and were sure indications that Norm had given a problem deep thought and had come up with a solution and good arguments to back up his proposal.

Norm often asked for favours of many people, but never for himself. His requests were always aimed at helping someone or an organization that was in need. His simple friendly approach, and his known integrity usually succeeded in him getting the help he was seeking, which he would pass on with humility.

Norm was a warm and generous man - a good bloke. He is missed.

Mr Denis Walker

Honorary Life Member of Sutherland Shire Cricket Association

I regarded it as a privilege to nominate Mr Denis Walker as honorary life member of our association

Denis has been closely associated with Sutherland cricket for more than sixteen years and had helped us to some extent for years before that.

His principal involvement has been as the Sutherland Shire Council's parks committee clerk, in which capacity he has given invaluable assistance, particularly to me as association secretary, in the endless tasks of maintaining a smooth running operation and trouble free competitions. Denis has recently been transferred from this position thus paving the way for this nomination. His direct relationship has been as an active member of Taren Point Cricket Club for several years and also as regular scorer for his son Adrian's team with the Gympsea Bay Cricket Club.

Denis had a natural interest in cricket in England before coming to Australia. He had the wonderful experience of playing village green cricket in York, but principally for the small township of Bridport in Dorset, where he was a regular member of the second XI.

As the council's officer charged with the responsibility of overseeing all parks, playgrounds and sporting areas in the shire, Denis amassed a vast knowledge of our region and met many people who had a single interest responsibility for their own particular sport. Inevitably conflicts occur when a variety of interests are competing for and on particular areas. Denis, with his sound judgment and sense of fairness, applied wisdom to these conflicts and usually negotiated a result acceptable to all concerned. Over the years cricket has been party to many of these conflicts, and subject to much criticism, but the cooperation we have offered and the reasonableness of our actions were always taken into consideration.

Inevitably, our association, at times with almost 2000 members competing in up to 100 teams in 13 grades, has been called upon to account for the actions of a player or a team. With guidance from Denis, combined with strong action by our executive committee, these difficulties have been ironed out with dignity and justice, maintaining the high standing and good name of our game. Let it not be thought that in conflicts with other interests cricket has always been the winner, or that when a cricketer has offended the complaint has been overlooked. Not so! But with Denis Walker to umpire in these disputes, cricket and cricketers have never been dealt with unfairly. I have no doubt that administrators of other sporting associations would support what I have said in this regard in matters that have affected their particular code.

Just as direct and valuable has been Denis' assistance to cricket in our gaining and developing new grounds. New playing fields have been a rarity in recent years, but in the early 1970's had it not been for the help cricket received from Denis, our association would not have enjoyed the number of grounds now available to it. Consequently many cricketers would have been denied the opportunity to participate in the game.

As an example of positive help to cricket in gaining the use of extra playing fields I cite Boys Town. Cricket was a sometimes user of this area and had to compete with various sports and activities. With advice from Denis, we were able to arrange for Br James Hamilton to secure for Boys Town a regular weekly payment from the council for the maintenance of the area, and Boys Town did not overlook our part in this help to them when their fields were allocated.

Another example is that on Denis' recommendation our cricket association became the only sporting body in the shire that had the privilege of its executive committee making the decision on whether wet grounds could be used despite the display of the official "GROUND CLOSED" sign. Our executive committee has accepted the trust placed in them with responsibility and certainly would not abuse it.

Yet another gain of cricket through Denis is quite a few practice wickets, properly constructed, around the shire. Also, many old style practice areas were upgraded and made safe for use by our members.

A lot more could be said about the help Denis has afforded cricket, but it will remain unsaid. Much has been done behind the scenes. Suffice to say that without timely warnings and help from Denis Walker cricket would not have been as enjoyable as it has been for so many of us.

Though Denis has been most helpful to me and therefore to cricket, he has, as a council officer, maintained his integrity and in my dealings with him never breached his loyalty and responsibility to his employer.

Although Denis has played cricket his chosen sport is hockey. He is now in his 41st year of competition hockey, having played his first year in England and then taken advantage of the seasons to play in the same year on his arrival in Australia. He has played through the grades and has represented with Sydney veterans.

Naturally this nomination could not have been made while Denis was directly involved with parks administration, though I believe he earned it long ago. Bearing in mind that he is still a council officer, I contacted him and informed him of my intention to nominate him in this way. I did this so that Denis would not be embarrassed either personally or in his workplace. Initially he was obviously taken aback, but his response says more than I could write in many pages. He said:

"I have only done my job. Nothing like this
has ever happened to me before."

It was most gratifying to hear Vince Ridge and David Dee speak in support of the nomination of Denis as life member, and it is now a matter of record that the honour was awarded to him unanimously.

REPRESENTATIVE TEAM REPORTS

MARTIN SHIELD (Manager Jim Field)

Round 1 versus Hornsby Kuring-gai at Kenthurst. Lost on First Innings. We lost the toss and were sent in. Most of our batsmen got a start but failed to carry on - Phil Stevens 45, Ian Mitchell 27, Shaun Potter 22, Steve Kelloway 21. We were dismissed for 174. Our bowlers stuck to their task in tremendous heat, with Steve and Mick taking most of the load. At one stage we had them 5 - 88, but with fielding errors we let them off to total 7 - 218. Mick Earl took 2 - 41 (14 overs) and Steve Kelloway 2 - 60 (22 overs).

Round 2 versus Southern Districts at Don Dawson. Lost on First Innings. We won the toss and batted, losing our first wicket early. Good batting from Ian Mitchell 63 Mick Hoare 51 and David Neill yielded 201. We had them 3 for 71, but they took their total to 3 - 208.

Round 3 versus Hawkesbury at Richmond. Lost on First Innings. They won the toss and batted. Our bowlers did a good job to keep them to a reasonable score after an opening stand of 124. After 57 overs they scored 7 - 239. We got away well - 65 for the opening stand, and at the end of play we were 8 - 185, losing on a countback. Batting: Mick Hoare 43, Ian Colee 35, Ross Shying and Glenn Carroll both 24. Thanks to Martin Carroll (16 yr old brother of Glenn) who filled in for us and took 1 - 18 off 2 overs.

Round 4 versus Gosford Wyong at Umina. Won on First Innings. We lost the toss and were sent in to bat. Brilliant batting from Mick Hoare 112 (15 fours), Raji Kooner 44, Phil Stevens 30, Mick Earl 30, Ross Shying 26 and Mick Irrgang (who filled in) 13 enabled us to total 292. Excellent bowling by all saw Gosford dismissed for 158. (Mick 3 - 39, Steve 3 - 38, Raji 2 - 25).

Round 5 versus Parramatta at Caringbah. Lost on First Innings. They won the toss and batted. First wicket fell at 140. Second at 205. After 57 overs they were 5 - 235, Steve Kelloway taking 4 - 81 from 20 overs, which was a fantastic performance considering we dropped 11 chances - most off Steve's bowling. Again our batsmen got starts: Raji 30, Mick 22, Ian 22, Mick H 19, but we were dismissed for 139.

Thanks to all the players who supported Mick throughout the season, especially those who made themselves available when we were short, Mick Whitcombe, Ross Shying David Failey, Mick Irrgang and Martin Carroll.

The team and I would like to congratulate Mick Hoare on his superb batting display for 238 runs at 47.6. It was a pleasure to watch him get them. His was the first century since Paul Mansfield in the 1982 - 83 season. His great effort with the bat has won him the Bill Wakely Trophy.

Round 1 versus Gosford at Wyoming. Won on First Innings. We lost the toss but then bowled and fielded well to contain Gosford to only 166 runs. What looked an easy target seemed nigh impossible when we slumped to 5 for 17, but a marvellous 6th wicket partnership of 81 runs between Jim Lee and Gary Lockwood set us on the road to a great victory. Best performers were Jim Lee 72 no and two good catches, Gary Lockwood 50, Greg Thomas 4 - 45 and Anthony Dale 2 - 53.

Round 2 versus Georges River Penshurst at Gannons. Lost on First Innings. We elected to bat first but following a slump in the middle order we managed only 180 despite a flamboyant 28 from Col Grimble, a steady 48 from Anthony Dale and a scintillating 32 from Todd Brunton. Our bowlers could not contain them, however and they passed us with 2 overs to spare. Best bowlers were A.Dale 3 - 69 and G.Thomas 2 - 69.

Round 3 versus Parramatta at Ringrose. Lost on First Innings. At last our batsmen seemed to have achieved an unbeatable total of 261 runs with Col Grimble scoring 93 in 106 minutes and Anthony Dale consolidating with 64 no. But our bowlers could not contain another strong batting side and they passed us with six overs to spare. Best bowler was Col Grimble with 3 - 44.

Round 4 versus Southern Districts at Cabramatta. Lost on First Innings.
In a disappointing match, we were again unable to contain a strong batting side and Southern Districts comfortably reached 250 runs. We could only achieve a meagre total of 100 runs. Best performers were C.Grimble 19 and 1 - 65; C.Williams 18, T.Brunton 12 and 2 - 43, T.Kooner 5-78.
