PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Ladies and Gentlemen,

I am sure the majority of you would agree that we have enjoyed a very successful 1987 - 88 cricket season. We were certainly fortunate to have very little interruption because of bad weather and particularly to have such fine days for the finals when you consider how much rain we have had so far in 1988.

Congratulations to all of the Premiers and individual trophy winners and better luck next season to those teams who were runners-up or who missed out on the finals this season.

We still have a few problems troubling our cricket in the shire, notably teams still forfeiting and clubs not ensuring that teams carry out fully their duty umpiring. I have stressed before the need for clubs to sign on only those players who give an undertaking to be available for most of the games and who will perform their umpiring duty when called upon. If players are not prepared to do this they make it very hard to organise a team that will provide enjoyment to their team mates and to opposition teams. Our cricket association would be much better off with fifty teams who turn up each week with a full complement of players and who carry out fully their duty umpiring obligations than with having a larger affiliation of eighty or ninety teams a number of whom only turn up when it suits them.

Last season there were thirty games where duty umpires failed to attend. In some cases the games concerned were vital to teams trying to make the finals. The Executive has resolved to increase the penalties for not fulfilling duty umpiring requirements next season and clubs would be well advised to bear this in mind when arranging their registration of players and nomination of teams.

We were shocked to hear of the sudden death of Greg Mason from the de la Salle Club. Greg was a fine cricketer who had just begun his career. To his young family we offer our sincere condolences.

To the great majority of clubs and team members I would like to convey the thanks of the Executive for the cooperation given during the past season and I hope you will have a successful 1988 - 89 season.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

The past season commenced with fewer than 1200 players, but subsequent registrations built up the strength of membership to 1365. The competition was conducted in 12 grades with 80 teams from 28 clubs. These statistics reveal a reduction in membership, teams and clubs. Two clubs - both at one time strong competitors, failed to put forward nominations - Cumberland and Port Hacking.

The shorter playing season, with the continuing necessity for fields to be repaired and maintained, again caused difficulties, but assistance and cooperation from council officers enabled the association to function with a minimum of disruption.

In recent reports I have noted that some clubs have been poorly administered, resulting in forfeits, non-response to executive communications and requirements, and other acts of non-interest. Regrettably, this approach at club level has deteriorated further, and it may now be said that many, not some, clubs fall into this category. This has had the automatic result of a reduced opportunity for genuine members to enjoy a properly administered and regulated association with our sport, both on and off the field.

The executive committee believe that they run an association of high standard, in the past admired and envied by other associations and organisations. But any committee is only as good as the membership it represents, at any level, and an appeal is made for association members and clubs who have hitherto taken but not given, to nominate responsible and genuine persons to take office with both the association and clubs, so that enthusiasm is engendered or rekindled and appropriate communication regained.

Incorporation of our association has been effected, and the certificate is expected to be issued prior to the adjourned annual general meeting.
