PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Ladies and Gentlemen,

First of all I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate the Premiers in each grade and the individual trophy winners who should be justly proud of their achievements over the past season. Also I extend commiserations to those teams who were beaten in the finals (I know how you feel), but they should take heart from the fact that if a team makes the finals, they have enjoyed a successful season.

I think that you will agree that we were extremely lucky to complete our season when you consider the amount of rain we have had since the middle of December. I can only recall one Saturday in December when some games were washed out. Let us hope the grounds will have dried out by the second Saturday in September.

The penalties introduced at the beginning of last season for teams not performing their duty umpiring responsibilities have certainly had the right effect. Only eleven matches throughout the season did not have two duty umpires in attendance. In the 1987 - 88 season this figure was thirty-three.

We are still receiving complaints about the standard of duty umpiring and in particular the inconsistency of umpiring. The Executive Committee has discussed this matter at length and it is proposed to recommend to the Annual General Meeting that the same duty umpires officiate on both days. This may pose some problems in rostering players to undertake their duty umpiring but team executives should bear in mind that it is important to improve the standard of umpiring and all team members should be prepared to participate and not just leave it to a few. In this way team members who umpire the first duty match should not be required to officiate at the second duty match.

The Executive has also endorsed suggestions for improving the rules of the sixty over matches put forward by a specially nominated committee and these suggested changes will be presented also at the Annual General Meeting.

Finally I would like to thank the Executive for their efforts on behalf of all clubs and members and congratulate them on their courage in making some very difficult decisions during the past year.

I hope that we can look forward to a dry and successful season commencing in September.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

The 1988 - 89 season was the last to enjoy the generosity of Sutherland Shire Council in providing playing fields at no charge to those using the facility. Rising costs and local government commitments have forced the Council to impose a user-pay charge and from the coming season we will have to meet this extra cost.

Sutherland Association has been fortunate in not having been burdened with this expense. All other local government authorities have levied users for many years. Our relationship with the Council is professionally friendly to our mutual benefit.

Last season our membership was slightly down with 1335 players in 75 teams competing in 11 grades of competition.

Our association is now incorporated, thus allowing members of the executive committee to perform their duties with confidence instilled by the knowledge of the backing of a proper legal entity.

Our long serving Treasurer Martin Taylor of the Sylvania Heights club, has intimated that he will not be available for re-election to that office. That is indeed unfortunate as Martin, following the precedent set by his team mate predecessor, John Boon, kept a tight rein on association finances. Further, by efficient management Martin has maintained our costs at the minimum, allowing our game to be the least expensive of all sports in the shire. All other cricket associations charge much higher fees. At meetings Martin has projected himself as a straight talking person with firm views on association matters on and off the field, the result of long experience. His contribution to our association has been valuable and he will be missed.

Congratulations to all players on a successful season.
