PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Ladies and Gentlemen,

Another season has come to a successful conclusion and for the Executive it has been a very busy one with many meetings going to midnight. However, we are fortunate indeed with the quality of the new young members of the Executive who have been keen and hard working and have gained a great deal of experience in a short time. I mention especially Bob Lightfoot, Junior Vice-President, Graham Thornley, Treasurer, Alan Lovegrove and Todd Brunton, Committeemen. Of course we still had the veterans leading the way in their usual efficient style and I take this opportunity of thanking all of them for their efforts on your behalf.

At the last council meeting of the Association on April 2nd an extraordinary General Meeting passed some very important changes to our playing rules:

- \* One day games from now on will comprise 45 overs each side instead of 47. These overs must be bowled before 3.55 pm. If not then the over in progress will be deemed to be the last over of the innings. The side batting second will then receive the same number of overs as the team that batted first.
- \* Where no play is possible on the first day of a two day match then the second day will comprise a game of 30 overs each side. Previously this was 31 overs each.
- \* A special over 40 years of age competition will be introduced next season provided we receive enough team nominations. The features of this competition will be:
  - one day games - 4 hours play - 30 overs each side
  - bowlers restricted to six overs in an innings
  - team nominations are to be submitted on August 13th together with proof of age of each player

We are sure that the competition will fill a need and will be well received by senior former players who have retired from the game but who would be prepared to play against players closer to their own age.

I take this opportunity to congratulate the premiership winning teams and the individual trophy winners. Also a special word of praise for Loftus A1 team who have now set a record of three premierships in A1 in succession since the introduction of finals.

We have one sad event to report and that is the passing of Bruce Russell of the Miranda Rangers Club, early in the season. Bruce was a stalwart of the club and to his family we offer our sincere sympathy.

Well, in a couple of months it will be all go again and I am sure that you are all looking forward to the new season. Thank you for your cooperation in the past and all the best for 1990 - 91.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

1989 - 90 saw 1450 registered players in 82 teams compete in 12 grades. This was an increase of 7 teams on the previous season and all available grounds were required despite the fact that this year for the first time clubs were obliged to pay the Sutherland Shire Council for the use of grounds.

We welcomed to the competition 2 new clubs, Bonnet Bay (who won the C3 competition) and St George's Engadine who played well in B7 grade.

During the season several alterations were made to the Competition playing rules and the production of the new rule book is almost complete. It will be available to all clubs early in the new season.

Once again the hard work of the grading committee resulted in tight competition in most grades. Though many clubs provide complete information on their players, some are still quite unfair and unrealistic in their expectations of the grading committee. Club secretaries are reminded that incomplete applications for registration will not be accepted and could result in team nominations being rejected.

Congratulations to the new members of the executive who learned quickly and pulled their weight in dealing with association business.

Association members are reminded that all positions are declared vacant and that elections are conducted to fill them at the Annual and Adjourned Annual General Meetings.
