VALE Rex King

Rex King, one of the most distinguished former administrators of our Association, passed away in September last year after a long and courageous battle with a very serious illness.

His association with cricket in the Shire goes back to the days before World War II in the old Sutherland Association. He was to the fore as a member of the inaugural committee which launched our Sutherland Shire Cricket Association in 1947, serving on that committee as Vice President, Assistant Secretary and Recorder all at the same time.

In the years that followed Rex occupied the positions of President, Vice President, Assistant Secretary, culminating in a period of twelve years service as Secretary from which position he retired in 1970. He was honoured with Life Membership in 1959.

Rex was an active participant in the game and played for many years as a batsman with Cronulla and School of Arts clubs. In later years he founded and played with Sutherland Tigers. He represented the Association in the Martin Shield competition on a number of occasions.

He was involved with the foundation of the Grade Club in the early 1960's and served on the inauguration committee.

During all these years Rex had the cooperation and support of his wife Daphne and his two sons, Greg and Lindsay, both of whom are well known and respected sportsmen in their own right.

To Rex's family we extend our deepest sympathy.

Brian Baker - Honorary Life Membership

At a recent council meeting of our association Honorary Life Membership was granted to Brian Baker, the Parks and Playgrounds Engineer of Sutherland Shire Council.

For many years the Sutherland Shire Cricket Association has been able to put on the field as many teams as have affiliated, largely as a result of the efforts of Brian.

Brian has developed areas unthought of as potential cricket grounds so that the growing needs of cricket might be satisfied. He has agreed to alter council's scheduled maintenance programs in order that our competitions might not be interfered with. He unhesitatingly has travelled to inspect grounds with cricket officials whenever the need has arisen. He has installed practice wickets with council assistance in many areas and has had damaged wickets repaired urgently so that our games could go on. His effort, together with Denis Walker, enabled the Boys' Town fields to be further developed and maintained, and our cricket has enjoyed the benefit of that project.

It might be said that in doing these things Brian has merely done his job. But, not so. Brian has "stuck his neck out" on more than one occasion, for cricket and any other sport where a good reason was obvious - all in the determined approach to make sporting facilities in the shire better for the users.

Brian has a no-nonsense and practical approach to all matters that come before him for decision. When our members have been at fault - and they have - he has told us so, but at the same time taken action to ensure that any action taken by council has been reasonable. When residents have complained without cause he has told them so.

Some time ago when school playing fields were withdrawn from weekend use it was Brian who was involved in the negotiations which led to a commonsense resolution.

Brian's chosen sport is surfing of many types, at which he was competitive and successful. His participation was mainly at Maroubra, but he has been and still is often seen participating at any of our shire beaches.

Regrettably, Brian was recently criticised undeservedly by cricket people. This action, if dealing with a lesser person, could well have damaged our good relationship and the future help given to the sport. However Brian, being the person he is, put forward the facts and the real history of events, answered his critics and continued to do whatever should be done for cricket.

Of course, Brian's assistance to cricket is but a sample of what he does for all sporting and recreation activities in the Sutherland Shire as any administrator with a good cause would affirm.

Honorary Life Membership of our association is not awarded lightly and is a well-deserved recognition given to Brian Baker. Without his guidance and help over many years our cricket would not be what it is today.

Don Masters - Honorary Life Membership

At a recent council meeting of our association Honorary Life Membership was granted to Don Masters, a recently retired cricket administrator.

Don has never played cricket, other than in the back yard at Mum's. He did say that he was chosen "right outside" for Cobar, many years ago. But he was the hard working secretary of Sutherland Shire Boys' Cricket for eleven years from 1980 to 1990, secretary of de la Salle cricket club for eight years from 1981 to 1987 and secretary of the Sutherland District Club for two years from 1981 to 1983, a time when the grade club was in real need of an experienced and tireless administrator.

Though Don has not played cricket, he has certainly been involved. He has passed coaching and umpires' examinations and is fully qualified in these areas. He has managed and coached boys' teams of varying ages, some with premiership success. Also he has managed and coached Moore Shield and Watson Shield teams for Sutherland. In addition, behind the scenes he has been a leading fundraiser for the de la Salle club.

Don has always been helpful and cooperative with officials of our association. He has not always agreed with our actions and decisions, but that is what progress and betterment are all about. All of us always had the best interests of cricket at heart, and as a result our game has been the winner in these discussions.

Don brought administrative expertise to the Junior Association at a time when it was urgently needed, and we are acutely aware of the successful progress made under his guidance. During his secretaryship of de la Salle, the grade club and the Boys' Competition between 40,000 and 50,000 registrations went through his hands, involving about 12,000 individuals. Many of these lads came to our association and helped to build up our strength from the local community. Many have gone to grade cricket and naturally, to other sports.

As an administrator Don was good, and a tireless worker. He was generous with his time and effort. He calls a spade a spade and there has never been a doubt that he has acted in the best interests of those whom he represented. His straight-forwardness is something that our executive committee was well aware of, and it was an admired personal trait.

Don, the astute local businessman, has unselfishly assisted many a young cricketer in the area with advice and in practical ways. Don, becoming aware of young and not so young with accommodation and financial difficulties, has sought them out and helped them.

The awarding of life membership of our association is a rather rare event. The awarding of honorary life membership is even rarer. Such an award to Don Masters justly acknowledges his valuable contribution to cricket as we know it.

This was a rebuilding season, only one player having played Durham Shield before and half the team first year out of the Boys' Competition. Although not successful, the team performed creditably and enthusiastically, showing fine team spirit. We were unfortunate to be in a very strong division with 3 teams from areas without grade clubs. Their stronger players were eligible for Durham Shield duties.

Our bowlers did well all series, the fielding of the team was always sharp. Our main problem was lack of experience in batting at this level. The bowling standard was high, most attacks contained bowlers who were very fast and our lads gained a lot of experience. Congratulations to Andrew Clements on winning the Rex King award, his 57 no on a dangerous pitch against Gosford was a gem. Geoff Phillipson captained the side well and the team ran like clockwork on the field.

Round 1 vs Camden at Sutherland. Sutherland 154 (A. Clements 48, G. Phillipson 35 no and 2-30) lost to Camden 2 - 175. Batting first on a pitch that kept low early, most of our batsmen were out bowled or lbw. The pitch dried out after lunch and our bowlers could not break through their top order. Camden won our division undefeated.

Round 2 vs Blacktown at Blacktown. Blacktown 175 (G. Phillipson 4-57, B. Turner 2-46, H. Hazeltine 2-24) defeated Sutherland 122 (T. Colbert 36, D. Edler 30). After the Durham Pit Crew just about rebuilt Hilton's car half way along Heathcote Road, we arrived at the ground to find the game had been transferred. We did well to restrict Blacktown to 175. Andrew Clements' outfield catch had to be seen to be believed. Blacktown's bowlers were too quick and too classy, though Troy, Daniel and David Shapero made the scorelook respectable.

Round 3 vs Gosford at Gosford. Sutherland 138 (A. Clements 59 no) lost to Gosford 139 (G. Turner 2-39, B. Turner 3-25, G. Phillipson 2-42, M. Spencer 2-27) We put them in and our bowlers performed extremely well to have them reeling at 5 - 45, but we let them off the hook and they recovered to make 139. Gosford had us in trouble early, some hostile bowling backed by tremendous catching. On a deteriorating wicket we slumped to 6 - 49 when Geoff Phillipson and Andrew Clements turned the game around. When our ninth wicket fell at 101, Brett Turner joined Andrew and they crept closer to victory. At 2 runs behind Andrew hit a ball through midwicket which was stopped by a desperate dive, allowing only one run. At one run behind poor Brett was given out caught behind off his elbow ! It is history now that Gosford went on and won the Durham Shield.

Round 4 vs Gladesville at Gladesville. Sutherland 178 (G. Turner 51, C. Floyd 39) lost to Gladesville 2 - 187 (C. Floyd 2-19). We won the toss and batted well for 178. Graham and Craig's partnership of 71 for the 5th wicket was tops. Looking for our 200, we lost our remaining wickets cheaply. An opening partnership of 159 put paid to our chances.

Round 5 vs Western Suburbs at Western Suburbs. Sutherland 112 lost to Wests 182 Geoff Phillipson 41, Mark Spencer 20 no, Graham Turner 3-48, Peter Kooner 3-38) Western Suburbs were vying for the division with Camden. Once again we did well to restrict them to 182 on a very fast outfield. Again our top order went cheaply to be 7 - 55 when Geoff and Mark combined for a 50 run partnership, highlighted by 2 big sixes from Geoff straight back over the bowler's head.
