We were blessed with fine weather for the finals, and the majority of matches were closely contested, and we thank the Sutherland Shire Council for ensuring that the pitches were cleaned, and the fields were mown. We also thank the Sutherland Shire Junior Cricket Association for their co-operation in allocating the fields for the finals, so that there was no clashing between our matches and theirs. Congratulations to the Premiership winning teams, and the individual trophy winners, and commiserations to the teams who came in second. I hope they can take heart from the fact that they played their best during the season.

Our main problem during the season, was the shortage of grounds, brought about by the council carrying out much needed refurbishment on some of the fields at various stages of the season. Gymea Bay Oval, (whole season), Gwawley North, Kareela North, Woronora Heights, and Sylvania Waters, were out of action, and this caused a great deal of consternation in re-scheduling matches, and at times we were lucky to get teams on the field. However, we do thank the council for their co-operation, and their understanding of our problems.

On the whole, the season was much easier for the executive than the previous one, with only a couple of reports of player misconduct, and no reported cases of ringins. However, it should be borne in mind by clubs and members, that this executive takes a very firm stand on such impropriety, and will come down very hard on offenders.

Congratulations to the Durham Shield team for a splendid season, where they reached the semi-final.

It is with regret that we learned of the passing of Jack Marston. A stalwart of the association during the early years Jack was a fine all round cricketer. To his family we extend our deepest sympathy.

Finally, I thank the executive for the hard work and dedication and extend to all members and their families best wishes for the 1993-94 season.

Administratively, the Executive was not overburdened with what might be termed breaches, and for this as Secretary I am grateful and congratulate club organisers.

As always, our association enjoyed excellent cooperation and assistance from Sutherland Shire Council. Recent changes in personnel at Council did initially give rise to potential concern, but in the event our liaison has not suffered in any way. No doubt this is in part the result of many years of the SSCA offering full support and cooperation to Council and its officers, sometimes in rather difficult circumstances.

Congratulations to successful clubs, teams and players.

I emphasise the importance of every team ensuring that results are appropriately advised and that scorebooks are properly completed. Present day and past members show a continued interest in results, and the major effort of Lance Handley in his role of recorder deserves loyal support.

All members are reminded that all positions are declared vacant and that elections are held to fill them at the Adjourned Annual General Meeting.

RECORDER'S REPORT

Congratulations to all the premierships winning teams. Five minor premiers were unfortunate to be defeated in the finals. Results were as follows:

There were 34 centuries scored during the season including a score of 178 by Steven Dinsdale from Como-Jannali C3 team. 23 bowlers took 7 wickets in an innings, 4 bowlers captured 8 wickets and Nigel Mills from Illawong B3 took 9-21. There was a high number of hat-tricks gained throughout the grades - nine in all.

It was disappointing for the players in the 11 teams who failed to submit their scorebooks. These teams were Loftus No 2 A1, St John Bosco A2, Como-Jannali B1, Caringbah DLS B4, Miranda RSL B5, Heathcote Services B6, Grays Point, Port Hacking Businessmen's and St Patricks B7, Miranda RSL C1 and Bonnet Bay C2. Some fine performances by players in these teams had been noted during the season but were unable to be considered for awards or inclusion in the annual report. I hope that players concerned will take to task those responsible.

Twelve teams failed to carry out their umpiring commitments, while 58 teams were late or neglected to submit their match result sheet. This was disappointing after last year's good effort.

At the present time there is a number of team competition trophies still missing. I would like to suggest that if clubs do not have a safe place of honour to keep them, that they be returned to the Association for safe keeping immediately after they have been awarded.
