VALE - FRANK JACKSON

Frank Jackson, one of the most distinguished administrators of our Association, passed away just prior to the commencement of last season, after a long and courageous battle with a serious illness. His association with cricket in the Sutherland Shire goes back to the days just after World War II. His early days were spent with the old Sutherland School of Arts Club. In the mid-fifties he transferred to the Miranda RSL Club with whom he continued to play until he was well into his fifties.

Frank was a fine bowler and a hard hitting batsman. His career did not follow the usual pattern of starting out as an opening bowler and then progressing, with age, to bowling spinners. In the 1950's, Frank was an off-spinner. Later, he increased his pace slightly and began to open the bowling in the lower grades with Miranda RSL. He was a very competitive cricketer, but personified how a true sportsman should conduct himself.

Frank became President of the Sutherland Shire Cricket Association in 1963 and served with distinction for five years. He was also greatly involved with the Miranda RSL sub-branch and assumed the presidential duties of that body for a number of years.

During all these years Frank had the support and cooperation of his wife Dulcie.

Here was a good man.

To Dulcie and the family, we extend our deepest sympathy.

LIFE MEMBER

Leon Bunker was elevated to Life Membership of the SSCA at the final council meeting of the 1993 - 94 season.

This was a fitting tribute to a man who has contributed enormously to cricket in the shire for over 25 years as a player, umpire, selector and administrator at both club and association level.

Leon first played in SSCA competition with the Kirrawee CC in B3 grade in the 1967 - 68 season and his impact was immediate when he took 10⁴ wickets in a season, a feat rarely achieved in our Association and well-nigh impossible nowadays under our present playing conditions.

After 7 years with Kirrawee, Leon joined SUSC for 3 years, moved to Gynea Bay for 2 years and then spent one year in the NSW Churches competition. In 1980 he rejoined SUSC and has played continuously with them since. Most of Leon's cricket has been played in the top grades and he has distinguished himself as a fine all-rounder and a cricketer of excellent reputation held in high regard by team-mates and opponents alike.

He was selected to represent the association in Durham, Telegraph and Martin Shield Inter-Association competition and achieved the rare distinction of captaining the representative teams at all three of these prestigious levels of competition.

In his desire to give back to cricket some of his expertise and experience, he has been a fine official umpire on occasions when his playing commitments have allowed him to officiate during the past seven years. He has also filled the position of selector of representative teams for some five years.

As an administrator, he has been Club Secretary of both Kirrawee and Sutherland United Services, Association Committeeman and Senior Vice-President, a position he has occupied since 1987.

Leon Bunker richly deserves the honour conferred upon him.

LIFE MEMBER

Bob Lightfoot was elected to Life Membership at the final council meeting of the 1993 - 94 season.

This award was conferred upon him for the service he has given to cricket during the past nineteen years.

Bob began playing cricket in the SSCA with Cronulla Sutherland Leagues Club in 1975 - 76. He then became a founding member of the Kurnell CC, Club Secretary and delegate to the SSCA for the next four years. Next, he became a foundation member of the Gwawley Old Boys CC, with whom he has completed eleven years, six of these as Club Secretary. His efforts and ability have been recognised by his club who have appointed him a Life Member.

Bob has been a keen and competitive player throughout his career and though he has enjoyed some successes as a batsman, it is as a skilful medium pace bowler that he has made his reputation on the field.

He gained his Official Umpires' accreditation in 1988.

Bob has been a member of the Executive Committee for ten years, six years as Chairman of the Mat Committee. For the past four years he has been Junior Vice-President of the Association.

His good humour, wise contribution to discussion, willingness to do more than his share in the running of cricket in the shire and his common-sense approach to the tasks of the administrator are much appreciated by his colleagues on the Executive Committee.

Congratulations to Bob Lightfoot on his attainment of this honour.

SECRETARY'S REPORT
