I would again like to thank Peter Friend, President of the Junior Association and Geoff Coleman, President of the District Club, and also their hard-working executives, especially Vicki Routh and Ray Brennan as well as our own hard working Graeme Thornley for the time they put into organising the new synthetic wickets and repairs to existing ones.

During the year the SSCA and SSJCA spent a total in excess of \$56000 on grounds and hopefully by the end of 1997-98, matting wickets will be a thing of the past. My thanks to Sutherland Council, especially to John Gordon and Murray Halls from Sport and Recreation for the help they have given us throughout the season in organising the scheduling for these major ground works to be carried out.

I must also express my appreciation to Michael Adams in his first year as President of the Umpires Association and to Syd Edwards, the Secretary, for the cooperation and support shown to our association during the year.

It is my sad duty to inform you of the passing of two men very well respected within cricket circles in the Shire. John Bannon, a Life Member of our Association and Alan Craston, a tireless worker for the Gynea Bay Club and the Junior Association will be greatly missed and our sympathy is extended to their families.

By the time this report goes to print it gives me great pleasure in announcing that a Cricket Council has been established within the Shire, consisting of representatives of the District Club, our Association, the Junior Association and Primary and Secondary Schools. With the assistance of the NSW Cricket Association, this council expects to be able to oversee and guide cricket development at all levels within the shire.

In conclusion, may I wish all members an enjoyable 1997-98 season and ask you to remember that if we all put in a little bit of effort, it makes the overall scheme run so much easier.

## SECRETARY'S REPORT

The competition was conducted in 13 grades, 12 of 7 teams and one of 5 teams. This was an increase of 5 on the previous year and 2 additional grounds were needed for the entire season. Fine weather prevailed during the finals weekend, which saw 4 minor premiers defeated.

Congratulations to Premiers and award winners who are listed elsewhere in this report.

Close cooperation with Sutherland Shire Council, especially John Gordon and Murray Halls, resulted in difficulties with grounds being speedily resolved. I would like to thank these two men for the great job they do to provide venues for all sports in the Shire and to attempt harmonious solutions to cater for the often unreasonable demands of all sporting administrators.

During the season we continued with our program of ground improvements which was interrupted several times by vandalism to grounds and wickets, factors outside our control, but which result in great inconvenience to players, administrators and the council. Any information which could help to stop vandalism is much appreciated by council officers and we ask you to report any item worthy of passing on. The final three concrete wickets were covered with synthetic eventually, and for the new season we will have 36 synthetic wickets, which will allow us to run 12 x 7 team competitions on synthetic wickets. A table showing the expenditure outlaid on grounds during recent seasons is included in this report.

Thanks to President Leon Bunker and the Executive Committee who worked hard again this year to enable the competition to run smoothly, to attend various meetings and functions and make decisions on your behalf.

Congratulations to Lance Handley for providing so consistently and so thoroughly the statistics which make up most of the Annual Report. Thanks again to Graeme Thornley for his responsible and thoughtful care of the Association finances. He is a most reliable Treasurer.

Noel Taplin managed the Durham Shield team which enjoyed a very successful season which saw them reach the final where they were defeated by Parramatta. Congratulations to them on a fine performance. Congratulations too, to the Sutherland District Club on another fine season, which resulted in their second consecutive 2nd grade premiership victory.

Unfortunately, several disciplinary matters occupied a considerable amount of time and attention from the executive committee this season, and I remind all players and club officials that we expect the game to be played hard, but as a game which should be enjoyed by both teams engaged in a match. There is no place for persistent and ongoing tactics which make cricket a miserable experience for players or umpires.

In last year's report we mentioned the serious illness of John Bannon. Sadly, John succumbed to his illness in late July 1996. John was a Life member and former Assistant Secretary of the Association. He was for many years a stalwart of Caringbah de la Salle Cricket Club. To his family we express our sympathy.

Alan Craston, former Secretary of the SSJCA and President of Gympie Bay Cricket Club passed away during the season also and a farewell message is printed elsewhere in this report.

I remind members that all positions are declared vacant at the AGM and encourage interested persons to offer themselves for election to a position on the Executive Committee.

### VALE ALAN CRASTON 1938 - 1997

During the season the Gymea Bay Cricket Club and Sutherland Shire Cricket was shocked by the passing of Alan Craston at the young age of 59 after a battle with cancer. Our deepest condolences go to Monica, Diana and Andrew.

I was lucky enough to begin my involvement with cricket administration around the same time as Alan. He became President of Gymea Bay in 1980 and under his leadership Gymea Bay grew from a small club to the very strong club it is today. Those involved with Alan during this period are well aware of the great respect in which he was held by all the players. Alan was made a Life Member of the Gymea Bay Cricket Club.

Alan coached a boys' team every season from 1980 and was coaching the 16A team last season. He began coaching with his son Andrew who now plays in our Senior competition. It was generally accepted that Alan was Gymea Bay's premier cricket coach and he always seemed to get the best out of the boys. He taught them not only cricket technique but also how they should play the game, in the right spirit.

Alan also became involved with the SSJCA, serving various seasons as Competition Secretary, Secretary and Vice President. Those familiar with cricket administration are aware of the workload that accompanies these positions and I know the tremendous amount of effort that Alan put in and the high esteem in which in which he was held by his colleagues in the SSJCA.

Alan became an official umpire after he retired as a player and as well as umpiring in our local competition, went on to umpire grade cricket. Unfortunately increasing work commitments curtailed his umpiring career.

The loss of Alan is a great blow to Gymea Bay Cricket Club and to cricket in general. Whenever problems occurred, Alan's counsel was sought and his wisdom resolved many difficulties. If cricket is a part of where Alan is now, I am sure he would be involved somehow, be it in umpiring, playing or administration. He was a great bloke.

There were 94 centuries scored during the season with the B4 (13) and B5 (14) being the most dominant. 24 bowlers took 7 wickets, nine capturing 8 and two 9. Eight hat-tricks were taken, including G. Hoffman of Miranda Hotel A1 who took four wickets with four balls.

The return of scorebooks this season, although many were late, was a lot better with seven teams failing to comply with the rules. The submission of match result sheets was disappointing, with 97 teams late or not submitting the required sheets.

Many scorebooks did not have the D sheet filled in, the "Summary of Averages" sheet in the back of the book, which made very difficult the task of compiling the figures for the Annual Report. These sheets are often referred to by the Grading Committee and should be completed by all teams.

Twenty teams failed to fulfill their duty umpiring commitments and two teams withdrew from the competition early in the season.

When I added them up it came to well over 200 seasons - close to 300 seasons of experience - most having played more than 20 seasons. This must be some sort of team record for the SSCA.

Finally congratulations to all the premiership winners and trophy winners. Congratulations also to President Leon Bunker and the Association Committee on running another successful competition.
