PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Once again when writing this report it is nearly the start of another cricket season.

Congratulations not only to the premiers but also to the runners-up for the true sportsmanship displayed throughout the finals. Congratulations also to the individual trophy winners on their success in the competition.

An overabundance of teams and a shortage of grounds forced us to reintroduce Sunday cricket on a rotation basis. This in itself proved a success however other complications did arise. Teams that registered barely the required number of players found that as the season progressed these numbers dwindled leaving us with a record number of forfeits and teams not doing their duty umpiring.

Clubs will find it very difficult to register these teams as the association will be looking at reducing the number of teams and going back to playing the entire competition on Saturdays only.

On a happier note, I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate the District Club on winning the First Grade Premiership and the Club Championship. Also of note is the fact that all five grades made the semi-finals.

The District Club created a first this year by becoming the only grade club to play an international side. This match was played at Caringbah Oval in January and anyone who attended would testify to its high success and I would like personally to congratulate all those involved, especially Tom Iceton who worked tirelessly to stage this spectacle.

I would again like to thank Peter Friend, President of the Junior Association and Geoff Coleman, President of the District Club, and also their hard-working executives, especially Vicki Routh and Ray Brennan for the time they put in organising with our own David Dee the wickets and grounds so that both associations could run trouble-free competitions.

I would also like to express my appreciation to Michael Adams, President of the Umpires Association and to Syd Edwards, Secretary of the Umpires Association for the cooperation and support shown to our Association during the year.

A special thank you to Todd Brunton, Lance Handley, Graeme Thornley, David Dee and the other willing workers of our committee for the time and effort contributed throughout the year.

In conclusion I would like to remind clubs when registering players to please ensure that they will be available all season and are willing and able to carry out their umpiring duties. This will alleviate the problems of last season. I would also advise clubs to think hard about the appointment of their team captains, as the decision on the right man for the job (not necessarily the most popular) could save both your club and our executive a lot of time spent at unnecessary meetings.

I wish all members an enjoyable and trouble free 1998-99 season.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

The competition was conducted in 14 grades, each of 7 teams. This was an increase of 2 on the previous year and a reduction in the number of grounds available required us to play 2 grades of the competition on Sundays with each team playing two Sunday rounds. This raised a whole new set of problems which we had not previously had to deal with. However, the cooperation of the Junior Association and of our own players enabled this project to proceed reasonably well. If it is possible we intend to run the competition next season entirely on Saturdays.

The finals were played without weather interruption and 6 minor premiers were defeated.

Congratulations to Premiers and award winners who are listed elsewhere in this report.

Close cooperation with Sutherland Shire Council resulted in many difficulties with grounds being speedily resolved. I would like to thank John Gordon for his assistance in this area throughout the season. Murray Halls, who has helped us for several years with grounds, was transferred during the year to a position with Bankstown Council. I thank Murray for all his help in previous seasons and wish him well in his new appointment.

During the season we continued with our program of ground improvements which was interrupted several times by vandalism to grounds and wickets, factors outside our control, but which result in great inconvenience to players, administrators and the council. Any information which could help to stop vandalism is much appreciated by council officers and we ask you to report any item worthy of passing on. Woronora Heights ground should be back in this season and two new grounds are planned for the Lucas Heights area. As our number of grounds is limited, so too must our number of teams. Hence the warning note in the President's Report.

Thanks to President Leon Bunker and the Executive Committee who worked together again this year to enable the competition to run smoothly and to make decisions on your behalf. Thanks to Syd Edwards for his regular attendance at meetings of the NSW Junior Union (now known as NSW Districts Cricket Association). Graeme Thornley again looked after the treasure chest capably, ending the year with a surplus!! Noel Taplin, as chairman of selectors oversaw the representative season, which this year was not so successful, though some excellent results were achieved. Congratulations again to Lance Handley on his detailed and thorough set of statistics which provide the material for most of this Annual Report.

Congratulations to Sutherland District Club on a great season which resulted in the Club Championship and the First Grade premiership.

Unfortunately, the Executive Committee was required to adjudicate on a number of incidents which occurred during the season. Most of these should never have arisen if common sense had prevailed. Behaviour such as sledging, attempted intimidation of players and umpires, ringing-in of players and drinking on the ground (to mention a few examples) are not wanted in our competition and should not have to be tolerated. I remind all players that cricket is a game to be enjoyed by both teams. It should never degenerate into an experience which is detested by players and umpires alike. Please do your bit to uphold the traditions of the game, even though sometimes the example we get from our test heroes is not encouraging. A quotation from Sir Pelham Warner 1903-04 MCC captain is worthy of note:

"The very word cricket has become a synonym for all that is true and honest. To say that is not cricket implies something underhand, something not in keeping with the best ideals"

I remind members that all positions are declared vacant at the AGM and encourage interested persons to offer themselves for election to a position on the Executive Committee.

The return of scorebooks was very disappointing with only half being submitted on time, eleven teams failing to submit their books. The submission of match result sheets was disappointing, with 132 teams late or not submitting the required form.

I must point out to all teams that for wicketkeepers to be eligible for an award their name must be on the top of the page in the scorebook, and the catches and stumpings must tally with the opposition scorebook.

Thirty-three teams failed to fulfill their duty umpiring commitments and six teams forfeited.
