I would again like to thank Peter Friend, President of the Junior Association and Geoff Coleman, President of the District Club and their hard-working executives, especially Vicki Routh, Ray Brennan and Russ Waddell as well as our own hard-working Graeme Thornley for the time they have put into organising the repairs and maintenance of synthetic wickets.

Cricket within our competition is now played entirely on synthetic wickets, although because of lack of grounds Sunday cricket is still essential. This will still remain in the future while the game remains so popular and because of our success in the World Cup I expect our numbers to increase again this coming season.

I must also express my appreciation to Michael Adams, President of the Umpires Association and to Syd Edwards, their Secretary and delegate to our Association for their cooperation and support shown to our association during the year and congratulate them on the increase in their numbers over the past few seasons and I'm sure this will continue under their guidance.

Special congratulations to Graeme Thornley on being elected a life member of our association. I am sure everyone appreciates his contribution to cricket during the past 11 years on the Executive Committee.

I would like to thank the willing workers of our committee for the time and support given during the year, especially Dave Dee, Lance Handley and Todd Brunton for their dedication and assistance.

The Executive had a reasonably trouble-free year with only a small number of players having to approach the committee and I'm sure that most of these could have been avoided with a little more knowledge of the rules by the Captains and a bit of common sense.

In conclusion may I wish all members and players an enjoyable 1999-2000 season and I hope that this may be our best season ever.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

The competition was conducted in 13 grades, each of 7 teams until the withdrawal of Heathcote in the B4 grade reduced that to a six team grade. This was a reduction of 8 on the previous season but still required one grade to play one Sunday round in order to accommodate all teams. Although there are some undesirable features in Sunday cricket, it appears that as our numbers grow it is difficult to do without it. After Australia's success in the World Cup we expect an increase in team nominations which will probably mean Sunday cricket again in the 1999-2000 season.

The finals were played without major weather interruption although a draw occurred in A2 grade and 5 minor premiers were defeated.

Congratulations to Premiers and award winners who are listed elsewhere in this report.

Continued close cooperation with Sutherland Shire Council resulted in many difficulties with grounds being speedily resolved. I would like to thank John Gordon for his assistance in this area throughout the season. Kirin Lindop was a great help with speedy notification of difficulties and methods of resolution.

Our program of ground improvements continued with a new wicket at Woollooware High School and refurbishments to Box Road, Gwawley West and Kareela South, all of which caused some inconvenience to players and administrators during the season. Thank you to the teams and clubs affected for your understanding and cooperation when sometimes the notification is quite late and relocations are necessary. If you live near a ground and you notice that it has been damaged, it is very useful if we get early warning of this. The Council are also very interested in tracking down vandals so any help in this area also is appreciated. For next season we should be able to use the two new grounds at the old Tip Site at Menai, a facility which has been available this year to the Winter codes.

Thanks to President Leon Bunker and the Executive Committee for their devotion to duty throughout the season. Todd Brunton deputised capably for Leon as required, Syd Edwards represented us regularly at the Sydney Cricket Ground meetings of the NSW DCA and Noel Taplin supervised the representative season which saw his Durham Shield lads make the semis. Congratulations again to Lance Handley on his detailed statistics which provide a large part of the contents of the Annual Report.

Congratulations to Graeme Thornley, our Treasurer for the past ten seasons on his election as a Life Member of the Association. Prior to becoming Treasurer in 1989, Graeme had been an Executive Committeeman for one year. As well as his Association duties, Graeme has been extremely active in the running of the Gympie Bay Club, having occupied the posts of Treasurer for 5 years, Publicity Officer for 3 years, Vice President for 1 year and President for 6 years. He has been honoured by his club as a Life Member also. He first played in the 1975-76 season and although he hasn't scored as many runs or taken as many wickets as he would have liked to, he has been a successful cricketer during his time with Gympie Bay. His success followed him into Representative Cricket where he has managed Durham, Telegraph and Martin Shield teams, his most noteworthy achievement being that of Manager of the winning Martin Shield side. He is also a successful local businessman and it is with great pleasure that I was able to nominate Graeme for this honour which is well-deserved as a result of his service to cricket in the Sutherland Shire. Graeme intends to relinquish the position of Treasurer for the coming season but is prepared to nominate for any other position on the Executive. Thank you Graeme for your past service and congratulations on your election as Life Member.

The NSW Districts CA has been active in the off-season in an endeavour to get all Associations onto a Computer network and training sessions will be attended by representatives of the association in late July. This is expected to improve communications with Associations.

Disciplinary problems were few during the past season and hopefully things will stay that way. A couple of players have to be interviewed by the Committee before they can begin playing next season. These interviews will follow the Adjourned Annual General Meeting.

I remind members that all positions are declared vacant at the AGM and encourage interested persons to offer themselves for election to a position on the Executive Committee.

Good luck for the coming season.

There were 74 centuries scored during the season. 32 bowlers took 7 wickets, twelve capturing 8 and two taking 9 while 3 bowlers took hat-tricks and one took a rare double hat-trick.

The return of scorebooks was again disappointing with less than half being submitted on time, sixteen teams failing to submit their books. The submission of match result sheets after each match was disappointing, with 100 teams late or not submitting the required form.

Checking wicketkeeping performances was very difficult. Many scorebooks did not nominate their wicketkeeper which made verification of their performance impossible. Due to this many keepers had the club figures reduced. I must commend the Miranda Magpies club as all their scorebooks had the wicketkeeper's name on the top of the page showing the opposition's innings.

I must point out again to all teams that for wicketkeepers to be eligible for an award their name must be on the top of the page in the scorebook, and the catches and stumpings must tally with the opposition scorebook. Eighteen teams failed to fulfill their duty umpiring commitments, ten teams forfeited and one team withdrew from the B4 competition after two matches.
