I would again like to thank Peter Friend, President of the Junior Association and his hard-working committee, especially Vicki Routh, Ray Brennan and Russ Waddell for the time they put into organising cricket and for their cooperation with our Executive.

I would like to thank Geoff Coleman for the years of dedicated service he has given to cricket at all levels, for his interest in and attendance at our Association meetings over the years. I wish him well in his retirement from the Presidency of the District Club and welcome Brett Johnson to the position.

I must also express my appreciation to Michael Adams, President of the Umpires Association and to Syd Edwards, their Secretary and delegate to our Association for their cooperation and support shown to our association during the year and congratulate them on the increase in their numbers over the past few seasons. I understand that Michael has decided not to stand for the Presidency this year and I thank him personally for a job well done.

I would like to thank the willing workers of our committee for the time and support given during the year, especially Dave Dee, Lance Handley and Todd Brunton for their dedication and assistance.

Cricket within our competition is now played entirely on synthetic wickets, although because of lack of grounds Sunday cricket is still essential. This will still remain in the future while the game remains so popular and I expect our numbers to increase again this coming season.

The Executive had a reasonably trouble-free year with a small number of players having to approach the committee and I'm sure that most of these could have been avoided with a little more knowledge of the rules by the Captains and the use of a bit of common sense. The reintroduction of the Captains' meeting assisted in this regard, although there are still too many forfeits and occasions when teams do not carry out their duty umpiring commitments.

I am looking forward to the 2000-2001 season and I hope that it will be an enjoyable one for all members and players.

## SECRETARY'S REPORT

The competition was conducted in 15 grades, twelve of 7 teams and three of 5 teams, a total of 99 teams, our largest ever. Two grades were obliged to play each Sunday so that all teams played 2 Sunday rounds. With no increase in grounds and an increase in player numbers anticipated for the coming season, there appears no alternative to some Sunday cricket. We need to approach the matter maturely and see if we can improve on our current situation.

The finals were played without major weather interruption although a draw occurred in B4 grade and 4 minor premiers were defeated.

Congratulations to Premiers and award winners who are listed elsewhere in this report.

Continued close cooperation with Sutherland Shire Council resulted in many difficulties with grounds being speedily resolved. I would like to thank John Gordon for his assistance in this area throughout the season. Kirin Lindop is a great help with speedy notification of difficulties and methods of resolution.

The new wicket at the Old Tip Site is a great asset and there should be a second one there this coming season. Thanks to all for their cooperation with security arrangements there. As this facility develops it will be a great advantage for the population at the Western end of the Shire and for cricket in general. Thank you to the teams and clubs affected for your continued understanding and cooperation when grounds become unavailable, as sometimes the notification is quite late and relocations are necessary. If you live near a ground and you notice that it has been damaged, it is very useful if we get early warning of this. The Council are also very interested in tracking down vandals so any help in this area also is appreciated.

Thanks to President Leon Bunker and the Executive Committee for their devotion to duty throughout the season. Todd Brunton deputised capably for Leon as required, Syd Edwards represented us regularly at the Sydney Cricket Ground meetings of the NSWDCA and Noel Taplin supervised the representative season which saw the Durham Shield lads make the final, only to lose narrowly to Hawkesbury. Thanks to the managers, Tony Dale (Martin), Noel Taplin (Telegraph) and Ray Davies (Durham). Their reports on the Representative Teams appear elsewhere in this report. Congratulations again to Lance Handley on his detailed statistics which provide a large part of the contents of the Annual Report. Lance's task would be made much simpler if team captains took more care with the presentation and submission of scorebooks. Indeed, as I perused some of them I wondered how a result was decided by the two teams!!!

This year the practice of awarding Medallions to individual award winners has been discontinued. A cash award will be paid to a player's club, who will then be responsible for any individual awards. The recorder has a number of awards from previous seasons which have not been collected from the Association.

The Gymea Bay club lost a stalwart this season with the untimely death of Jack Grigg who did a lot of work for and with young cricketers. A valedictory message appears in the Gymea Club report.

The Insurance Policy which we have taken out with Sportscover seems to be well received by Clubs and provides a measure of security which we didn't have a few years ago for a small premium.

The Secretary and Recorder have both been equipped with computers by the Association and we hope to improve our efficiency during the coming season.

Disciplinary problems were few during the past season and hopefully things will stay that way. I would remind all clubs that the Association rules expressly prohibit the drinking of alcohol during matches and I can never understand how players reported to the Association claim that they are not aware of this.

I remind members that all positions are declared vacant at the AGM and encourage interested persons to offer themselves for election to a position on the Executive Committee.

There were 84 centuries scored during the season. 22 bowlers took 7 wickets, three captured 8 and there was a record number of hat tricks, 21 in all.

The return of scorebooks was again disappointing with less than half being submitted on time, nine teams failing to submit their books, while five books were only submitted in time for their players' performances to be added after awards had been decided. Some potential trophy winners were disadvantaged by this.

I must point out again to all teams that for wicketkeepers to be eligible for an award their name **must** be on the top of the page in the scorebook, and the catches and stumpings must tally with the opposition scorebook. Twenty-two teams failed to fulfill their duty umpiring commitments, three captains failed to attend the captains' meeting and thirteen teams forfeited.

They moved to GyMEA in 1960 after the completion of the family home, which he had laboured over with a passion.

Jack played competition soccer at the age of 8. At 15 he took up rugby league and quickly gained respect for his ability, determination and never-say-die attitude. At 18 he decided to don the whites for the first time and he rapidly became a formidable opponent. His second season saw him take his first hat-trick and in his third was asked to trial for grade cricket and was selected. At this stage Jack decided to concentrate on family life and declined the offer. He was replaced by one of the reserves, none other than Bob Simpson. He returned to cricket again playing for Grays Point in 1968 and took on coaching the boys' teams in cricket and soccer.

He transferred to GyMEA Bay CC and continued playing until he was 53, when he was still opening the bowling in A2's with the team he had coached since boys. He decided to retire at this point after he had taken another young team through their teens, with that team today having success in several A1 premierships. In a career that lasted 37 years he took hundreds of wickets including 7 hat-tricks, the first in 1954 and the last in 1984. Because of his outstanding service to cricket and especially the GyMEA Bay Cricket Club, the club decided to make Jack a life member. Jack's ability as a player and coach was contagious and he was responsible for the strong performance and growth of the club during his period of involvement.
