This year with the introduction and re-wording of some laws of cricket, it will be extremely important for their attendance and commitment.

I am looking forward to the 2001-2002 season and I hope that it will be an enjoyable one for all members and players.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

The competition was conducted in 14 grades, twelve of 7 teams and two of 5 teams, an initial total of 94, which was reduced to 93 following the withdrawal of Como-Jannali in B7. Two grades were obliged to play each Sunday so that all teams played 2 Sunday rounds. As there will be no alleviation in the ground situation for next year, Sunday cricket will still be a feature at least as frequently as this year, since an increase in our player numbers is anticipated.

The finals were played in fine weather and in a year of upsets, only five minor premiers were successful. Congratulations to the Umpires' Association on their unprecedented feat of standing 2 umpires at each final.

Congratulations to Premiers and award winners who are listed elsewhere in this report. As for last year, cash awards will be paid to a player's club and the club will then be responsible for the presentation of awards to individual players.

Continued close cooperation with Sutherland Shire Council resulted in many difficulties with grounds being speedily resolved. I would like to thank John Gordon for his assistance in this regard throughout the season. Kirin Lindop is a great help with early notification of difficulties and methods of resolution. This line of communication will be even more important next season as there will be an extensive program of ground improvements and maintenance.

Thank you to the teams and clubs affected for your continued understanding and cooperation when grounds become unavailable, as sometimes the notification is quite late and relocations are necessary. If you live near a ground and you notice that it has been damaged, it is very useful if we get early warning of this. The Council are also very interested in tracking down vandals so any help in this area is appreciated.

Thanks to President Leon Bunker and the Executive Committee for their devotion to duty throughout the season. Todd Brunton deputised capably for Leon as required, Syd Edwards represented us regularly at the Sydney Cricket Ground meetings of the NSWDC and Noel Taplin supervised the representative season which saw the Telegraph Shield team make the semi-final only to miss out without a ball being bowled due to the wicket being unfit for play. Thanks to the managers, Tony Dale (Martin), Steve Whippy (Telegraph) and Ron Arnold (Durham). Their reports on the Representative Teams appear elsewhere in this report. Congratulations again to Lance Handley on his detailed statistics which provide a large part of the contents of the Annual Report.

Sadly I report the death earlier this year of Terry Fisher of Sylvania Heights Cricket Club after a long and courageous struggle with sickness. A valedictory message appears with the Club reports.

Disciplinary problems were few during the past season and hopefully things will stay that way. The incidence of alcohol-provoked matters was not an issue this year and the committee would like to think that this indicates a more mature attitude on the part of players. Two incidents which bring discredit on the whole association – deliberate damage to a playing field and an alleged attempt at match-fixing – were dealt with by the executive during the year.

The new Laws of Cricket (2000 Code) will be adopted for the coming season and the Umpires' Association have planned a session to inform players of changes made. It is anticipated that all teams will be in possession of a copy of the Laws and Association amendments prior to the commencement of the season.

In addition to becoming conversant with the Laws, all clubs should ensure that their teams are capable of scoring their matches correctly. My perusal of scorebooks during the past season and in the preparation of this report have made me aware of the poor standard of scoring exhibited by many teams. This matter will be addressed early in the season.

I remind members that all positions are declared vacant at the AGM and encourage interested persons to offer themselves for election to a position on the Executive Committee.

Another season completed! There were 94 teams, 5 less than last season. To be able to get the statistics onto the computer it is necessary for all teams to submit the result sheet on time. Many teams were late or even failed to lodge a result, making it very difficult to record statistics accurately. Team nomination forms and match result sheets must be filled in correctly and only on the official forms. After the completion of each match the match result sheets **must** be submitted on time. We may have to change one of our drop-off points, as on many occasions Sol's Supermarket was closed early.
