SECRETARY'S REPORT

The beginning of this year's competition was thrown into turmoil with the withdrawal of 2 teams, the steep upgrading of another and a redraw following Round 2 for the C grades which eliminated the five-team competitions. The competition eventually saw 90 teams contest 12 seven-team grades and one six-team grade. Two grades were obliged to play each Sunday so that all teams played 2 Sunday rounds. As there will be no alleviation in the ground situation for next year, it is most likely that Sunday cricket will still be a feature at least as frequently as this year.

The finals were played in fine weather and four minor premiers were defeated. Congratulations to the teams who participated in the finals and commiserations to the runners-up.

Congratulations to Premiers and award winners who are listed elsewhere in this report. As for last year, cash awards will be paid to a player's club and the club will then be responsible for the presentation of awards to individual players.

Despite close cooperation with Sutherland Shire Council we encountered several ground difficulties this year. The program of relaying and recovering wickets caused some problems. Poor weather at the beginning of the season interrupted the program and a misunderstanding over its resumption caused some heartburn. Thanks to Manager, John Gordon and Kirin Lindop from Council Parks and Playgrounds for their assistance and cooperation during a difficult year.

Thank you to the teams and clubs affected for your continued understanding and cooperation when grounds become unavailable, as sometimes the notification is quite late and relocations are necessary. Thanks also to those Association members who live near a ground and notify us when they see that there is something amiss with the ground.

Thanks to President Leon Bunker for his steadfast efforts during a difficult personal season. Todd Brunton deputised capably for Leon as required, until he resigned in February 2002. Congratulations to Syd Edwards on his Life Membership award. Syd also represented us regularly at the Sydney Cricket Ground meetings of the NSWDCA and Noel Taplin supervised the representative season which saw the Martin Shield No 1 team make the semi-final only to miss out very unluckily and the Martin Shield No 2 team defeated by the narrowest of margins in their final round. Congratulations to the Durham Shield team on their magnificent effort to reach the final. When it was washed out, they were fittingly declared Joint Premiers. Thanks to the managers, Tony Dale (Martin No 1), Todd Brunton (Martin No 2) and Ron Arnold (Durham). Their reports on the Representative Teams appear elsewhere in this report. Congratulations again to Lance Handley on his detailed statistics which provide a large part of the make-up of the Annual Report. Thanks to all other Executive Committee members for their work and support during the season.

Lance Handley has announced his retirement from the Association Executive after three decades of service. Lance has always been a fair, diligent, thoughtful and hard-working member of the Executive. Never one to shirk a difficult situation, Lance's lifetime contribution to cricket is one of which he can be extremely proud. His wife June has also been an Association stalwart and has provided great assistance to cricket throughout the years. They will both be the recipients of a suitable commemorative award from the Association. Thank you both for a lifetime of service.

Sadly I report the death on May 15 this year of Rosemary Bunker, wife of Leon, after a long and courageous struggle against serious illness. Another great cricket stalwart, Ivor Chalmers passed away in May.

A few disciplinary problems marred our 2001-2002 season. Players were reported for misconduct in their dealings with other players and umpires. Penalties ranged from a reprimand to a 5 match suspension.

May I take this opportunity to thank all Club Secretaries, Delegates and Executive Committee members for their courtesy, cooperation and understanding in their dealings with me over many years. I have decided not to contest the position of Secretary in the coming season. I am aware that Noel Taplin is prepared to stand for the position and if you elect him, please give him your support. I intend to offer myself for the position of Recorder.

I remind members that all positions are declared vacant at the AGM and encourage interested persons to offer themselves for election to a position on the Executive Committee.

RECORDER'S REPORT

The season started with 92 teams, but two sides withdrew without looking at the strength of the opposition, one from B6 and one from A3 grades. We were able to redraw the C grades preventing a bye in the B6 grade due to a team in C3 requesting a higher grade. (It was pleasing to see a team request a higher grade as most complain at being graded too high). They were rewarded by winning the B6 competition. The A3s were not so fortunate and a bye resulted in this competition thus shortening their season by two matches.

When we look at some of the performances in the lower grade competitions (eg D. McInnes 838 runs and 50 wickets, B. Riley 808 runs, C. Behringer 806 runs, J. Hunter 585 runs and 68 wickets) it is obvious that some players were undergraded and clubs with higher grade teams should look at least to trying them in their top grades, as all players are allowed two games up before they have to be regraded. This would assist the grading committee in assessing the ability of players and give some clubs a bit more credibility when they winge about gradings.

Thanks to all Captains who submitted their results, filled in correctly, on time. As some captains feel it is not necessary to get the result of their games to the recorder, it makes the task of keeping the point score up to date and recording all information very difficult.

82 players scored centuries of which 7 scored 150 or more, while there was one double century. 21 players took 7, two took 8 and one took 9 wickets in an innings, while 7 bowlers captured hat-tricks. Seventeen teams did not complete their duty umpiring, while 12 teams forfeited and 11 captains failed to attend the compulsory Captains' meeting. The return of scorebooks was again disappointing with less than half being submitted on time. Many came in late while 11 were not returned. Some arrived after I had completed all the statistics but I relented and included them in the final figures.

Again I must point out that for wicketkeepers to be eligible for an award their name **must** be on the top of the page in the scorebook. Only 25 scorebooks had wicketkeepers listed, while others had the keeper's name in the back of the book with catches nominated that could not be verified as keeper's catches.
