RECORDER'S REPORT

The competition was conducted with 84 teams in 12 grades each of 7 teams.

Thanks to those Captains who submitted their results, filled in correctly, on time. Most teams cooperated in this regard, and this enables me to keep the point score up to date. I think that all players are entitled to know what happened in their grade and it is really very inconsiderate of those who fail to submit Result Sheets.

Congratulations to all Premiership winning teams. Eight Minor Premiers were successful in the finals. The results were:

88 centuries were scored including 5 in excess of 150. The highest score for the season (190), could not be verified, as the team scorebook was not submitted. The player concerned would have also won the Batting Aggregate for B9 grade. On 11 occasions bowlers took 7 wickets in an innings, 2 took 8 and 1 bowler took 9 wickets. A notable effort was the 7-0 taken by J. Sanders of SUSC in A1 grade. 16 hat tricks were achieved, the best being Jeff Keats 5 wickets in 5 balls in B6 grade. Fourteen teams, six of which were in B9 grade, did not fulfill their Duty Umpiring obligations, 4 team captains let down their teams by non-attendance at the compulsory Captains' meeting. Three of the 8 forfeits were by one team in B4 grade.

All but three scorebooks eventually arrived, but the late return by some clubs puts me behind with compilation of award winners and other statistics. I was able to uncover some information from the Match Result Sheets, but of course, the late scorebooks are usually those from teams whose Match Result returns were haphazard and are often incomplete.

I will be making several recommendations to the new executive which I expect will improve this situation.

Scorebooks were generally very poorly kept. In only 3 grades was the standard sufficiently high to merit a scorebook award. Congratulations to those 3 brave souls.

Wicketkeepers are a race very dear to my heart and I tried to find an award winner in each grade. Unfortunately it seems that most of our wicketkeepers prefer to remain anonymous, as do most of those who take catches.
