RECORDER'S REPORT

The competition was conducted with 94 teams in 12 grades each of 7 teams and 2 grades of 5 teams

Thanks to all Captains who made the effort to submit their results, filled in correctly, on time. There was considerable improvement in this regard this season, which makes it possible to keep the point score up to date.

Congratulations to all Premiership winning teams. Eight Minor Premiers were successful in the finals and six were defeated. The results were:

100 centuries were scored including 9 in excess of 150. The highest score for the season was 186. Two batsmen scored 4 centuries and fifteen scored 2 centuries each. On 15 occasions bowlers took 7 wickets in an innings while the best was 8-48 in B4 grade. Twelve hat tricks were achieved including 1 double hat-trick.

No team managed to remain undefeated during the season and only one side was unable to win a match.

A2 and C1 grades were the only ones where all teams fulfilled Duty Umpiring and Captains' Meeting obligations. 28 teams failed to do Duty and 7 captains let down their sides by not attending their compulsory Captains' meeting. Four of the 13 forfeits were by one team in B4 grade.

Eventually I received 90 of the 94 scorebooks. Thank you to the club officials who spent time completing all sections, especially Sheets B, C and D. If these are done, all falls into place easily and a comprehensive record of the season is available. I find it hard to understand how a club can make awards to its players if it has no record of their performances. A copy of Sheet D is retained by the Association to assist with grading in subsequent seasons.

Scorebooks were generally very poorly kept. In only 4 grades was the standard sufficiently high to merit a scorebook award. Congratulations to those 4 brave souls, three of whom won awards last season.

Again, despite extensive searches, it was difficult to verify Wicketkeepers' performances; indeed in many books it was difficult to identify who the keeper was, especially if he bowled occasionally. Also, please try to get your teams to note the names of those who take catches just as they note the name of bowlers.

Phew! How much controversy can you squeeze into 2 months of cricket? It all began after the first game when the Sri Lankan 2nd XI blatantly accused us of cheating in the scorebook. As this attack was personal, it didn't go down too well with those having fingers pointed at them and things nearly turned nasty. Order was quickly restored, with both umpires staying back well after stumps going over the books with a fine tooth comb. It was finally agreed that the dispute on the result should go before the NSWDCA Appeals and Disputes Sub-Committee. Eventually, after 2 months, justice prevailed and our victory was confirmed.

The other time we were stuffed around was in the 3rd round. The NSWDCA informed us that this game was to be re-scheduled at Bankstown Oval.
