The competition was conducted with 92 teams in 11 grades each of 7 teams and 3 grades of 5 teams. Thanks to all Captains who made the effort to submit their results, filed in correctly, on time.

59 centuries were scored with a highest score of 174 no. Bowlers took 7 wickets in an innings on 18 occasions, the best being 9-16 by M Carroll in B2 grade. Fourteen hat tricks were achieved, two by W Crich in C2 and 2 by M Thorpe in C1 grade.

Only in three grades did all teams fulfill their Duty Umpiring and Captains' Meeting obligations, yet there was an improvement in the number of Forfeits recorded - 6 in all this year.

Seven teams failed to submit scorebooks, but many of those submitted were incomplete.

Scorebooks again were generally very poorly kept. In only 4 grades was the standard sufficiently high to merit a scorebook award. Congratulations to those 4 valuable members of their respective clubs.

Wicketkeepers again were difficult to identify and dismissals were often recorded rather haphazardly. If I couldn't verify the dismissals I couldn't recommend an award.

I would like to put on record my appreciation for the efforts of Sutherland Council Sport and Recreation Officers, particularly Jodie Banks and her Manager, John Gordon who endeavoured to keep as many cricket wickets playable as possible throughout the summer. It was a particularly difficult season and all teams were affected to varying extents by ground changes caused by maintenance and repair. Thanks to club and team officials for their cooperation in seeing that the draw worked. It's getting more complicated every year.
