REPRESENTATIVE TEAM REPORTS

Daily Telegraph Shield

Once again I would like to congratulate the side on a terrific season. This season's side would have to be one of, if not the most talented side that I have had to manage. As well as talented, they were also a great bunch of guys with never a dull moment. It was a shame to see them bow out of the finals in what could only be termed controversial circumstances. This side was by far the best in the competition and hopefully will be back next year for the Martin Shield.

Every player in the side played an important part in this year's campaign and it was a shame that the Rep season does not last longer. It showed in stats that they could match any side, losing only two games by less than 30 runs. In fact our team qualified equal first, but we were relegated to third spot on quotient.

Round One was against the unknown "India Club" who amassed nearly 270 runs at Caringbah. Our guys never looked like losing and piled on the runs with ease, a welcome relief for this manager indeed.

Round Two we travelled to play last year's winners, Hornsby. Again, our on fire batting lineup smacked Hornsby black and blue for a shade over 300. Our newly developed bowling attack really clicked and sent the premiers packing for 182.

Round Three at Caringbah was a walk in the park against the lacklustre Fairfield side and we romped home by 150 runs.

Round Four was the game that cost us a better quotient. In 40 degree heat at Bankstown, we lost the toss, had to bowl, but made light work of Bankstown, rolling them for only 122. After reaching their total in 29 overs and only 3 wickets down, we decided to do the gentlemanly thing and call off the game instead of chasing more runs and wickets which could have had so much bearing later. Once again I accept the majority of the blame for that.

Round Five at Sutherland against Camden was always going to be tough. Bowling first we managed to keep Camden to 214, a good effort in the conditions. Batting second is always difficult at Sutho and that day was no different. It was one of those days where you watched the prize slowly drift away, so close it was cruel. Camden knew we did not play to our full potential and were concerned about facing us in the finals.

The semi-final is best left unmentioned. After being relegated to third place on quotient, we played on a poorly prepared surface, lost two players at the last minute and then nothing went right on the day. Edges falling just out of reach, some poor decisions and generally an unpleasant opposition meant that the only good thing was the resolve it put into the minds of our players to do better next year.

A really big thankyou must be extended to all the family, friends, teammates and officials who attended the games. Our guys appreciated the support and encouragement. Thank you, too, to Mrs Riley, who spent a lot of time and effort in organising afternoon teas at the home games – she makes the best pikelets in the Shire, bar none, thank you.

Once again to the players, thank you for a great season and the pleasure of being involved with such a top bunch of blokes. Normally I would be expected to nominate a best player award. This year I asked the team to vote for a "Players' player".

Durham Shield

2006-2007 proved to be a year of much improvement for the team, both individually and collectively. We learnt some valuable lessons about what it takes to play and win at cricket in varying and challenging conditions and against more experienced opponents.

We started our campaign against competition heavyweights Hawkesbury at Richmond Oval, the beginning of a steep learning curve for the coach, captain and the team.

Although we lost that opening match, we set ourselves a series of challenges that we began to achieve. We ended up winning two of our five matches and almost sneaked into the semi-finals with a strong performance in the last round.

Despite the loss of three games, we gained the experience needed to turn these defeats into wins in future seasons. We learned how to bat and bowl on green tops, on typical Sydney pitches which play lower throughout the day and how to set attacking fields to take full advantage of both playing conditions and opponents.

Because of our limited experience on turf wickets and the lack of variation of our own synthetic surfaces, it is invaluable to the Durham Shield and senior Shield sides to be exposed to cricket on turf in the Representative competitions. It is important, too for our squad to take what they learnt from this season into the next one, be it in Durham, Telegraph, Martin Shield or Grade Competition.

The matches we won, we won well. We took the lessons learnt at training and applied them in the games. Congratulations to the whole squad for their efforts during the season. A summary of notable performances is listed in the match results.

Special thanks to all the parents who carted the team around the Sydney area for the away matches, assisted with the scoring and helped with setting up of afternoon tea at home matches.

Winner of the Rex King Trophy was our Captain, Daniel Brett who scored 189 runs at an average of 37.8.

80 centuries were scored with a highest score of 231 no and eleven other scores above 150. Two batsmen scored four centuries each and two others scored three centuries each. Stewart Vella of Engadine Dragons B2 had an exceptional season with 903 runs. Bowlers took 7 wickets in an innings on 10 occasions, 8 wickets on 3 occasions and the best was 9-25 including a hat trick by Glenn Stevenson in B1 grade. In all, seventeen hat tricks were achieved, two by K Hilzinger in B3 grade.

Only in two grades did all teams fulfill their Duty Umpiring and Captains' Meeting obligations, one team withdrew midway through the season and 8 other forfeits were recorded.

Twenty teams failed to submit scorebooks, but many of those submitted were incomplete.

Scorebooks again were generally very poorly kept. In only 6 grades was the standard sufficiently high to merit a scorebook award. Congratulations to those 6 valuable members of their respective clubs, four of whom are old hands and previous winners of scorebook awards. Welcome to the 2 new winners!!

Wicketkeepers again were difficult to identify and dismissals were often recorded rather haphazardly. If I couldn't verify the dismissals I couldn't recommend an award.

I would like to put on record my appreciation for the efforts of Sutherland Council Sport and Recreation Officers, particularly Jodie Banks and her Manager, John Gordon who endeavoured to keep as many cricket wickets playable as possible throughout the summer. John moved on to another position during the year and was replaced by Ray Whiting who is also aware of the needs of cricket. Jodie has moved on also and we welcome back Kirin East, who has long been a help to us in the administration of Sporting Fields. It was a particularly difficult season and all teams were again affected to varying extents by ground changes caused by maintenance and repair. Thanks to club and team officials for their cooperation in seeing that the draw worked.
