SECRETARY'S REPORT

It has been my great pleasure and honoured privilege to serve the SSCA members as Secretary for the 2007/08 season. This season was one of positive change and momentum, which I hope will continue into the upcoming seasons.

We introduced an updated version of the By-laws. Particular thanks go to Lance Taylor, Michael Mooney and David Dee who spent much of the off season consolidating a number of resolutions and changes that had occurred since the last revision of the by-laws had been published.

My personal favourite change saw the reintroduction of sixes into the SSCA competitions. I thank the members for supporting this initiative, particularly the mature way in which awarding of sixes was implemented and accepted by Captains, umpires and players alike.

It was however a difficult year with regards to discipline of some players. This past season, it was necessary to convene a number of judiciary hearings into reported player misconduct, and a number of suspensions were issued. For the most part, Captains are taking more responsibility for the behavior of their players, unfortunately a few rogue individuals spoiled this effort for everyone. I mention this, not to dwell on the negative, however to point out the positive actions that the SSCA Executive take to address, correct and educate player misconduct. It is important that the Captains continue their efforts also, to ensure that these types of incidents are eradicated from our competition in the future. Thank you to all the SSCA executive and delegates who were involved in the judicial process this season.

Thank you to the SSCUA for their support throughout the season. This year we experienced an unprecedented increase in the number of official umpires appointed to matches. I was also encouraged by the marked improvement of duty umpires. Special mention must go Grant Davidson and Brendon Tanti who produced the duty umpire guidance sheets at the beginning of the season. No doubt that this initiative has resulted in another positive outcome.

It would be impossible for us to run our competition without the tireless work of our Recorder, David Dee. Thank you for your assistance and guidance to me during this past season. In support of our recorder, thank you also to Nick Calder, who continued his great work on maintaining and developing our website.

We could not have achieved all of the above without the strong leadership of our President Noel Taplin. Additionally we were well supported by Jeff Keats and Allan Lofthouse who gave up much of their time behind the scenes to ensure we could get the job done.

Due to increasing family and work commitments, I am unfortunately unavailable to continue my role as SSCA Secretary. I encourage the positive changes that we have made and believe it is important that the Delegates in partnership with the SSCA Executive continue to move forward.

I remind all delegates that all positions are declared vacant at the Annual General Meeting and encourage those interested to nominate for election to the Executive Committee.

We are facing a number of serious challenges in the near future, which I will flag here for future discussion and consideration:

- Increasing demand of registered players, particularly from the SSJCA and providing a defined path for
 juniors coming up to be mentored and developed to representative level.
- Increasing demand on available grounds and facilities and pressure on the SSCA from competing interests such as winter sports and competing summer sports.

I am sure that with the great input from Delegates and the Executive alike, we can address these issues to ensure future sustainability and growth of our competition.

RECORDER'S REPORT

The competition was conducted with 1536 registered players and 84 teams in 12 grades each of 7 teams. Thanks to all Captains who made the effort to submit their results, filled in correctly, on time.

Congratulations to the Premiership winning teams. Only four Minor Premiers were successful in the finals while eight were defeated. Third placed teams were successful in A2, B5 and B8 Grades. The results were:

78 centuries were scored, including 2 double centuries, with a highest score of 209 (by L Winder in B3 grade) and six other scores above 150. Five batsmen scored two centuries each. Bowlers took 7 wickets in an innings on 18 occasions, 8 wickets on 3 occasions and 9 wickets twice, the best being 9-13 by D Twining in B2 grade. In all, ten hat tricks were achieved, including a double by G May in B1.

Only in four grades did all teams fulfill their Duty Umpiring and Captains' Meeting obligations, while six forfeits were recorded. All scorebooks were eventually sighted at the end of the season, though not all were completed. All of this was a big improvement on the previous year.

Scorebooks again were generally poorly kept, sometimes with matches omitted. Six people put in hours to keep their team's scorebook in good condition and I congratulate them on their effort, rewarded by a Scorebook Award. Two other books were well kept, but not always by the same person.

Wicketkeepers again were difficult to identify and dismissals were often recorded rather haphazardly. If I couldn't verify the dismissals I couldn't recommend an award.

On a personal note, although he may not be remembered by many present-day players, I would like to record with sorrow and affection the passing in Brisbane of Reg Courtney, who graced the field during the late 50s and the 60s with North Cronulla, St Patricks and Cronulla Workers Clubs. Reg represented the Shire in Telegraph and Martin Shield with distinction and we were teammates for many years. Another giant of the early years of the SSCA who passed away in January 2008 was Doug de Witt, late of Cronulla and Engadine who played with School of Arts and later with Southern United. For many years Doug held the honour of Association individual highest score.

I would like to put on record my appreciation of the efforts of Sutherland Council Parks and Playgrounds Officers, particularly Jess Goddard, Kirin East and Manager Ray Whiting, who endeavoured to keep as many cricket wickets playable as possible throughout the summer. During a difficult season most teams were again affected to varying extents by ground changes caused by maintenance and repair. Thanks to club and team officials for their cooperation in seeing that the draw worked.
