REPRESENTATIVE TEAM REPORTS

Durham Shield

Despite the initial loss to heavyweights Camden in Round 1, we were able to turn that loss into a positive learning experience throughout the season which culminated in a final appearance (again against Camden) where unfortunately Camden prevailed again despite Sutherland setting a highly competitive total and remaining in the game until fairly late in the day. Although it was disappointing to stumble at the final hurdle, it should be noted that Sutherland did really well to get as far as they did.

There was much to admire about Sutherland's efforts – winning three games and losing two in our march to the finals. There was fantastic bowling, batting and catching at different times in the competition and the team responded well to the challenges put before them and seemed to grow in confidence as the season progressed. The only real hiccup after our first game was the loss to Hornsby in Rd 4 on a wicket that historically does not suit the team batting second.

To the contrary, in the Rd 3 game against Fairfield/Liverpool we batted first and made only 122. While heads were down at the change of innings break, no one conceded defeat and we ended up winning by 33 runs, rolling Fairfield for 89. Fairfield in the end actually did well to reach this total. This was the sort of confidence that got us to the Semi-final and Final appearances.

Congratulations to the boys on a fantastic effort – there is no doubt that we have a real chance of going one better next year with most of the same personnel available and valuable lessons learned. Win or lose they played the game the right way. Many thanks to all the parents who made me feel at home and who were very supportive of me and the boys by setting up afternoon teas and travelling long distances early on Sunday mornings to away games and offering assistance in any way they could. On and off the field it was a great effort all round.

Martin Shield

Our season didn't get off to the greatest start losing two players overnight and already having some of our more experienced players missing. We lost the toss and predictably at Sutherland were asked to bowl first. Our bowlers did well dismissing Churches for 158 with the spinners taking six wickets between them.

Batting second on Sutherland Oval is never easy but the pitch didn't play a part in most of our dismissals and neither did Churches' bowling. A lot of us threw our wickets away with poor shot selection and we were rolled for 98 in less than forty overs. Only Grant Davies put up any resistance top scoring with 37. Despite losing this match, we took a lot from it and the lessons learnt were valuable.

Bundy Big Plays:

There were no Bundys awarded after this game, however we took a lot of motivation after hearing that a number of the Churches players rubbished our chances to opposition sides throughout the rest of the competition. Thanks boys!!

Round 2 versus Sydney Morning at Tasker Park

Sutherland 8 for 208 defeated Sydney Morning 122

After a change of grounds due to wet weather we won the toss and elected to have a bat. Consistent early wickets saw the middle order having to knuckle down and forget about scoring runs to stem the flow of wickets. This proved to be a bit boring for Brett Bullock who decided to get off the mark with a six and followed this up with another a few balls later. Bullock's 79 not out gave us a competitive total of 208 from our 50 overs.

We knew we would have to bowl well to restrict Sydney Morning and we started well with Friedman taking early wickets and Martin conceding less than a run an over. Riley and Thompson then came into the attack and between them took the next seven wickets to have Sydney Morning dismissed for 122.

Bundy Big Plays:

Bully's entire innings was hugely entertaining, starting and finishing his dig with sixes. Thommo's four wickets came in a hurry and prevented Sydney Morning from building any significant partnerships. Honourable mention to Marto who managed to unsettle the opposition batsman by not only bowling well but sledging their attempts at facial hair.

Round 3 versus Camden at Memorial Oval

Sutherland 9 for 289 defeated Camden 111

Coming into the third and final round match, we knew we had to win and win well to have any chance of making the playoffs; this would seem a tall order coming up against Camden who were undefeated thus far. Winning the toss again, we chose to bat first and again didn't start well losing a wicket in the second over. Mike and Grant came together and played with great maturity, mixing good running between wickets with regular boundaries. Some quick scoring from the middle and lower order took our total to a very good one of 289.

Going into the game with two of our recognised bowlers out, we knew we needed a good start to stay in control of the match and we got that through Matty and Marto both of whom took early wickets and took the game right away from Camden. Once again Blake and Thommo cleaned up the lower order and we had dismissed Camden for 111. It was during this innings that we really evolved as a side, all the bowlers bowled really well and stuck to our plans perfectly. They were backed up by great fielding and attitude from the rest of the boys.

Bundy Big Plays:

Grant's innings was probably the highlight of the season, he came in when we were 3 for 30 and in big trouble. It couldn't be said that he smashed them all over the park because 16 of his 17 boundaries came between point and backward point but his chanceless knock of 119 won the game for us. Quarter Final versus Parramatta at Glen McGrath Oval

Sutherland 7 for 241 defeated Parramatta 165

Getting a home Quarter Final and being able to play at Caringbah again was very rewarding for us right from the start of the day. After winning the toss Parramatta decided to send us in and we had one of our better starts with Blake looking in great touch early. Another batting collapse saw us looking shaky at 5 for 80 after thirty overs, once again we had blokes put their hands up and take it upon themselves to get us out of trouble. Thommo and Hughsey shared a great 8th wicket partnership of 112 which all but ended Parramatta's chances.

Once again early wickets were the key to us restricting Parramatta and Marto provided that taking four of the first five wickets and beating the bat on many other occasions. Matty also played a large part coming on and taking the last four wickets in quick time.

Bundy Big Plays:

Thommo's innings of 95 not out was a spectacle for all; in his own very unique style he hit boundaries to all parts of the field. Highlights included his three sixes which were muscled well over the fence and his lap sweeps off the pace bowlers.

Marto's fiery spell of bowling set the tone for our bowling innings; he never let the batsman get on top of him mixing accurate swing bowling with some well aimed short balls.

Knowing the flat nature of the pitch, we knew we still had plenty of work ahead of ourselves and luck didn't go our way early. Our bowlers beat the bat consistently and looked well on top of the batsman but the opposition rode their luck and saw plenty of streaky shots result in boundaries. We tried plenty of bowlers and tried to implement different plans but little went our way until the moment that changed the game and set us on our path to the grand final.

THE RUN OUT – In an effort to inspire his troops Skip had moved himself out to the long on boundary and worked tirelessly cutting off many would be boundaries until the moment arrived. Canterbury were building what looked to be a big partnership and it was evident that something special was needed to break it. With another ball seemingly on its way to the boundary, Skip bolted around and intercepted it just before it hit the fence. Amazingly in the one motion he picked the ball up one-handed and flung it back striking the one stump he had to aim at, leaving the batsman well short of the crease.

Canterbury never recovered from the run out and were eventually bowled out for 259. Hughsey and his seven wickets also played a part in their demise.

Mike's innings was near perfect, he continually turned the strike over barely facing a dot ball, and this hard running between the wickets was accompanied by some well placed boundaries and a huge six over mid wicket.

Hughsey's 18 straight overs with seven wickets was a Herculean effort. Shaking off injuries getting no help from the pitch, he just kept running in doing his job, his energy and never say die attitude kept the rest of us going and ensured we got the win.

Blacktown never really got going with us taking regular wickets and keeping things tight in the field. 99 centuries were scored, with a highest score of 188 no (by P Barnes in A2 grade) and six other scores above 150. Three batsmen scored three centuries each, P Mamone in A2 grade, D Ottmann in B1 grade and M Elliott in B2 (for Aquinas who did not submit their scorebook). Seven other batsmen scored 2 centuries each. Bowlers took 7 wickets in an innings on 15 occasions, 8 wickets on 4 occasions, the best being 8-11 by A Grinham in B7 grade. In all, eighteen hat tricks were achieved, including a double by P Hughes in A1 and 6 wickets from 7 balls by N Heath in B7 Grade. Only in two grades did all teams fulfill their Duty Umpiring and Captains' Meeting obligations, while twelve forfeits were recorded.

Scorebooks again were generally poorly kept, sometimes with matches omitted. Some clubs have adopted a computer program to keep their statistics, but most of these are very poorly kept and do not provide an alternative to submission of the scorebook, the official record of the season. Also, I can't give a scorebook award to a team whose scorebook is incomplete. Four people put in hours to keep their team's scorebook in good condition and I congratulate them on their effort, rewarded by a Scorebook Award. Four other books were well kept, but not always by the same person. Wicketkeepers again were difficult to identify and dismissals were often recorded rather haphazardly. If I couldn't verify the dismissals I couldn't recommend an award.

As the years pass we lose more of the earlier Association stalwarts. I refer to the passing of Les Kirk, a former Recorder of the Association. Les managed Watson Shield Teams and played with School of Arts in the 50s and 60s. I would like to put on record my appreciation of the efforts of Sutherland Council Parks and Playgrounds Officers, particularly Jess Goddard, Kirin East and Manager Ray Whiting, who endeavoured to keep as many cricket wickets playable as possible throughout the summer. The new wicket at Canberra Street will have to be reported on after the Winter season. Thanks to club and team officials for their cooperation in seeing that the draw worked despite the many interruptions caused by ground repair and maintenance during the season
