## Representative Team Reports

### Daily Telegraph Shield

The Telegraph Shield squad this season consisted of 15 young players drawn from 7 different SSCA clubs.

**Round 1 Sutherland 193 def Georges River St George 114 at Bexley Oval** (Cameron Jenkins 58, Joey Simpson 38, Cameron Jenkins 2-12, Matt Darby 2-17, Mark Cullen 2-24, Ryan Silburn 2-30, Chris Male 1-24)  
A great all-round team performance especially in the field defending a total reduced due to rain delays. With the opposition 6-88 chasing a reduced total of 134 we looked in trouble. We took the last four wickets for 26 runs to record a fantastic first-up win.

**Round 2 Sutherland 5-206 def Fairfield-Liverpool 194 at Glenn McGrath Oval** (Joey Simpson 90, Cameron Jenkins 46, Cameron Jenkins 3-27, Bryce Moriceau 3-48)  
Another great display in the field with Cameron and Bryce taking the last six wickets for 19 runs. Following a great opening partnership from Cameron and Joey, another solid batting display gave us our second win of the season.

**Round 3 Sutherland 132 lost to Camden 2-144 at Memorial Oval Ingleburn** (Bryce Moriceau 30 no and 2-15, Matt Darby 23)  
Missing a couple of players, a changed batting line up after losing early wickets and coming up against last year's premiers saw us comprehensively beaten. After 2 good wins it was back to the drawing board, but we saw enough to know that we were capable of being competitive against Camden if we got to meet them in the finals.

**Round 4 Sutherland 5-149 def NSW Churches 140 at Ron Routley Oval Concord** (Jaime Pontey 92 no, Dave Smith 25, Cameron Jenkins 4-30, Bryce Moriceau 2-27, Luke Annesley 2-41)  
After the Christmas break we bounced back with a great win, taking the last 7 wickets for 23 runs. A superb batting display led by skipper Jaime (92 no) saw us back in the winning circle and looking good to qualify for the finals.

**Round 5 Sutherland 9-283 def Inner West Harbour 140 at Sutherland** (Luke Annesley 73, Jaime Pontey 55, Joey Simpson 37, Ryan Silburn 25, Scott Metham 23 no, Matt Darby 21, Matt Christison 15, Bryce Moriceau 3-30, Cameron Jenkins 2-34, Chris Male 2-34)  
We needed a win to book a place in the finals, the first for Sutherland for many years. A great batting performance led by Luke and Jaime saw us post a formidable 283 runs from our 60 overs. Great enthusiasm was shown in the field led by Matt Christison (who had hit 2 massive sixes earlier) with a fantastic outfield catch and a direct hit run out from the boundary. A convincing win put us into the semi-finals.

**Semi Final Sutherland 5-122 def Hawkesbury 120 at Richmond Oval** (Matt Darby 32, Cameron Jenkins 27, Jaime Pontey 23, Ryan Silburn 19, Bryce Moriceau 3-17, Cameron Jenkins 3-19, Ryan Silburn 3-33)  
We were confident we could be competitive against the undefeated Hawkesbury team. Consistent rain saw the game transferred from the turf of Richmond Oval to a local synthetic wicket and reduced to a 40 over contest. Hawkesbury got away to a good start and at lunch were very confident of victory. After lunch we came out firing and led by Cameron, Bryce and Ryan, took the last 7 wickets for 33 runs to dismiss them for 120. In the face of some very fired-up Hawkesbury boys, solid batting from Cameron, Jaime, Luke, Ryan and particularly Matt at the end saw us record a famous victory and qualify for the final.

### Final vs Camden at Memorial Oval Ingleburn

Rain washed out the final in week one and the match was rescheduled for the following week. On an overcast February day we headed out west on a team bus arriving to more rain and a covered wicket. Camden had gone through undefeated (including a comprehensive win over us in Round 3) and were very confident of victory. The more it rained, the more confident we became as we thought we could turn the tables on Camden in a shorter format game with our full team after our great semi-final win. However persistent rain through the day made any play impossible and eventually the game was called off and the Telegraph Shield shared by the two teams.

I must admit we were happier than Camden with the shared result, but it was a great reward for a team that hadn't won a game the previous season, who played in the best spirits of the game throughout the season, who consistently played well as a team every game and had input from every player involved at some stage of the season. The post final celebration at Bangor Tavern was a fitting finale to a great season for a fantastic group of young men who did themselves and Sutherland cricket proud. Player of the Year was Cameron Jenkins, but it was a close call between Cameron and several other players as well as the secret weapon, the BBQ trailer which attended every game and inspired many late innings wickets after the lunch break. I hope the boys will get back together next season and have a crack at retaining the Shield. Thanks to all of our supporters who attended games this season. It was great for the boys to have supporters at every game.

## Durham Shield

### Round 1

The season started with a home game against Camden at Raby on an overcast day. Having lost the toss and fielding first the team bowled Camden out for 158 off 40 overs. After the lunch interval, the openers faced 4 overs before a 45 minute rain interruption, reducing the game to 44 overs. Best of the batsmen were Andrew 44\*, Matt B 22 and Luke with 15. Sadly the boys fell agonisingly close to victory, 3 runs short of the revised total of 121.

### Round 2

Round 2 we ventured north to the Glades, where we played against Hornsby Kuringai. After winning the toss Matt R proceeded to dominate the bowling attack with a superb 108, assisted by Chris 39, and a quick fire 32 from Pat D, finishing with a total of 7/236. The boys followed up with a strong bowling and fielding effort, restricting Hornsby Kuringai to 8/134. Notable bowling efforts from Vaughn 4-44, Matt B 4-8 and Brent 2-17. A convincing victory for us.

### Round 3

Our first home game for the season kicked off against Parramatta, the then competition leaders. After losing the toss and fielding, and a scary first 2 overs which went for 19 including a monster 6, the boys got on top early, taking wickets at a constant rate, bowling Parramatta out for 134 off 35 overs. Pat D 4-26, Andrew 4-19, and Vaughn 2-36 were mainly responsible for this fine effort. The boys then went out to bat and after losing both openers in the first 4 overs, Ryan 50, Chris 38 and Connor 19 steered the team to a resounding victory with 19 overs remaining.

### Round 4

After Christmas we travelled to Mount Pritchard to play against Fairfield Liverpool, on a synthetic pitch. Having lost the toss and fielding again, the boys had control of the game up until the 9th wicket partnership of 30 runs pushed the total to 178. Best of the bowling was Matt B with 5-46, and Pat C made 2 stumpings and a catch. Ryan stood out in the failed run chase with 35, closely assisted by Matt R with 31, and Chris 20. We were bowled out for 135 in the 43rd over.

### Round 5

Round 5 was back at Tonkin for the final round of the regular season against Blacktown. Winning the toss and batting, the boys batted very well scoring 8-296 off 55 overs, assisted by an opening stand of 73 from Matt R and Luke. All batsmen contributed, with Ryan 86, Connor 48, Matt R 45 and Matt B, with quick fire 40 including 2 huge sixes, top scoring for the team. The bowling was just as impressive, with Brent 3-20, Matt B 3-17, Pat D 2-22 and Ryan 2-15 dominating, bowling Blacktown out for 117. Pat C also took 3 catches. Therefore our stand in captain, Matt B decided to push for the outright, after much deliberation. Ryan took 2-19 in an eventful session, where Connor fielded at silly mid on, and Pat C almost taking a difficult outfield catch.

### Semi Final

Versus Parramatta at Merrylands, on a rainy overcast Sunday, fate played against us when we decided to bowl first on a dubious looking pitch, needing victory to progress. Parramatta ended up with 9-243 off 52 overs. Ryan took 6-53 in an excellent spell, assisted by Pat D with 1-59 and Andrew 1-51. Chris also took 2 catches, with Pat taking a catch and a great stumping. With the pressure on, our batsmen stumbled in their attempt to keep up with the run rate, with wickets falling constantly. Connor was the backbone of the innings with 36, assisted by Ryan 27. Matt B gave us a glimmer of hope toward the end of the innings, scoring a quick 23, including 2 sixes. However this was not enough and we bowled out of the Durham Shield. Great season boys, unlucky not to progress further. Congratulations to Ryan who took out the Player of the Season award.

These statistics are simple to view, thanks to the online system. The SSCA are to be congratulated for taking a massive step forward with the introduction of the online system, eliminating the need to manually write up match summary sheets and lodge them after each game. Tom Croucher's online system, which has been tremendously successful for the juniors, allows anyone with access to the internet to view match scores, results, competition ladders, honour board achievements and much more. Captains can log in and download their team statistics for end of season reports, etc, instead of tediously trying to reconcile scorebook data. Finals highlights were provided by three sides, with our A1 team making the Semifinals and our B4 and B8 teams finishing as Minor Premiers and Competition winners.

Congratulations to our B4 family team comprising at least 8 father/son combinations. They took out the Premiership for the third year running. Their "threepeat" began in C2 (2007/08), progressed to B7 (2008/09), and culminated in their successful year in B4. Special mention to our B8 team (the Juggernauts), who progressed from C1 runners-up (2008/09) to deserving B8 Premiership winners in 2009/10. Life members, Mark Monaghan (35 seasons) and Adam Young (36 seasons) played in the B8 team alongside their teenage sons, as well as mates who have young sons playing in our junior ranks.
