#### SECRETARY'S REPORT

The competition was conducted with 87 teams in 13 grades, 2 of 5 teams and 11 each of 7 teams, 4 teams less than the previous season. Seven Minor Premiers were successful in the finals while six were defeated. Second placed teams were successful in B4, B5, B6, B9 and C2 Grades. Third placed St John Bosco was successful in C1 Grade. The finals results were:
