The competition was conducted with 1484 registered players in 82 teams making up 13 grades, 8 of seven teams, 4 of five teams and one of 6 teams caused by the late withdrawal of one team unhappy with their grading. Thanks to all Captains who made the effort to enter their results, correctly and on time, but we were disappointed with those who entered theirs late and inaccurately. The issue of entering the names of Duty Umpires was again a difficulty and made the task of keeping the point score up to date more onerous than it needed to be.

Congratulations to the Premiership winning teams. Minor Premiers were successful in eight of the finals while five were defeated. Como-Jannali came from third place to win both the A1 and C3 finals. The results were:
