## **LIFE MEMBER**

I wish to nominate Michael Mooney for Life Membership of the Sutherland Shire Cricket Association.

Michael's Club career has been with the Cronulla Seagulls Cricket Club where he coached junior teams for ten years, joined the Committee in 1993-94 and worked as Registrar from 1994-95 until 2001-2002 when he was a leader in the process of the merging of Cronulla Seagulls with De La Salle Caringbah.

He was awarded Life Membership of Cronulla Seagulls CC in 2000.

With DLS Seagulls CC (incorporating Cronulla Seagulls CC) he was Vice President in 2002-2003, being elected President in 2003-04, which position he has occupied since that time.

During this period the number of junior teams rose from around 4 to around 10 plus Under 8s. There are now 4 men's teams which has risen from 1 or 2 when the clubs amalgamated.

During Michael's tenure as President the club has increased and improved training facilities, has adopted Club shirts and training gear, has increased sponsorships, has provided more skills days for the juniors and has developed into a more family oriented club.

Michael joined the Committee of Sutherland Shire Junior Cricket Association in 1995-96 and was Registrar for six seasons until 2000-01 when he was elected Secretary, a position he occupied until 2006-07. He was Vice-President in 2007-08. During his time with the juniors he was Delegate to NSWDC, Delegate to SSCA and liaised with Sutherland Shire Council on grounds and matters affecting cricket.

He became a Life Member of SSJCA in 2007.

In 2003-04 Michael joined the SSCA Committee as the representative of the SSJCA and has been on the Committee either in that capacity or as an elected Office Bearer since then. He has occupied the positions of Committeeman, Junior Vice-President, Assistant Secretary and Secretary. He has been our delegate to the SSJCA, our representative on the Sutherland Shire Council Sports and Active Communities Sub-Committee and our Delegate to NSWDC.

At a time when it is very difficult to encourage club members to work for the association as a whole, it is great to have someone as experienced and talented as Michael to take on the tasks which he has and thereby to let us feel that the running of the Association is in good hands.

Thank you, Michael for your many years of service to cricket and I hope that this will continue for a long time yet.

It is with a feeling of pride and privilege that I commend Michael's nomination to you.

There have been numerous significant individual achievements by players this season, 10 centuries scored by various players, 10 times players getting more than 5 wickets in an innings and some excellent wicket-keeping.

I would be remiss not to single out the performances of our Senior Cricketer of the year, Daniel Brett. In addition to setting new Club records for batting average and aggregate, he has won the SSCA awards for Batting Aggregate, Bowling Aggregate and Allrounder for the 2012-13 season.

Anthony Malouf's wicketkeeping performances were most impressive as he rewrote our club records for most dismissals in a season and won the SSCA award for wicketkeeping. Corey Cruickshank's effort of 8-9 ranks him third on our Club's list of best bowling performances.

As a committee we are continually trying to improve the quality of coaching, off field activities and back-up for players. On this front, depending on receiving a grant from the state government, we hope to replace the nets at Woollooware Oval. We also announced the first intake of 12 junior players for the DLS Seagulls Cricket Academy (which we know will improve and expand as we progress). The Academy will be seeking input from our men's teams to this new venture as we become a truly integrated cricket club.

## **St John Bosco CC**

The senior Bosco players were back for more punishment in the 2012-13 season. Five teams took the field this year, one less than last year after the A1s couldn't get a side together. We had 91 registered players, 59 of whom played full-time. Our five teams came away with mixed results. The B7s were the standouts, finishing Minor Premiers and just missing out in the final in a nail-biting finish. Unfortunately no other teams made the finals, but all had a good year.

Our Club Senior Player of the Year was Liam Hamling from the B7s. Liam hit 650 runs at an average of 92.86 including a club record knock of 193 in Rd 5 against Engadine Dragons. Liam also took 14 wickets at 23.21, took 9 catches and made 2 run outs.

Eleven centuries were scored by 8 different players. There were ten "five fors"(or more) by ten different bowlers. All teams were represented in both categories. There were also 2 hat tricks by Mick Lainson (B3) and Paul Barclay (B7).

Each of the teams played admirably. The B3s were elevated two grades after being put up four grades the year before. Michael Cross and I took on the co-captaincy. The team found it a bit difficult with the bat but managed to get a few wins on the board leaving us in sixth place on the ladder. There were some great individual performances from Matt Battam with the bat and Chris Postill and Mick Lainson with the ball.

The B5s were ably led by the seasoned senior cricketer Michael Vu. They finished fourth with a couple of big outright wins. Marty Dantas starred with the bat hitting over 500 runs for the season. He was well supported by Pat Eades and Jay Vincent. As usual, Paul Barclay and Pat Eades took a bag of wickets each.

The B7s came back for their second year of senior cricket after winning the C1 competition last year. Looks like they'll have to come back again next year after a great result in the B7 grade. Perhaps a few grades higher ?? As mentioned above, Liam Hamling was the standout player, but he didn't do it alone. Liam's father Neil also hit some handy runs, as did James Thomas, while Ethan Tudjman was devastating with the ball taking 34 wickets at 11.91.

The C1s returned after finishing the previous season as Minor Premiers. They struggled a little, managing only one win and finishing sixth. Due to injury and other unfortunate matters out of their control, the team was left without star batsman and captain, Jude Hennessy, for most of the season. Nevertheless, they had fun and I'm sure we'll be seeing them back next year.

Finally, the C2s were back with Captain Peter Burns again. They managed to string a few wins together to finish a comfortable sixth, an improvement on last year. Joel Raper stood out, with 386 runs at 48.25 and 19 wickets at 12.21.

Thanks to all the players, Captains and everyone who gave up their time to help out. It's not always easy to give up most of your Saturday to play cricket, but it is worth it.

### SSCA Recorder and Competition Manager's Report for Season 2012/2013.

After a somewhat shaky beginning after 2 team withdrawals at the last minute, season 2012/13 finally got underway with 68 teams in 10 grades of competition, the A1s being a 5 team competition, the B1 – B7 & C1 – C2 being 7 team competitions.

The season commenced in early September and immediately there were difficulties with teams getting the Cricket Online Results in on time and correctly. This also appeared to deteriorate further throughout the season with some teams being 6 times offenders in achieving this rather simple task. This serious problem will need to be addressed next season by the Clubs, it is hoped. We must be able to have up to date and accurate point scores after each round of the competitions so that the SSCA Management Committee is able to monitor each grade and its players. Those team Captains/Scorers that complied with getting their results correct and on time must be commended.

The management of "Late Registrations" will also need to be addressed in the coming seasons to avoid the (few) problems that did occur in season 2012/13. The Association had no less than 262 "Late Registrations" of the total of 1244 players registered (approx. 21%) this past season and if the grading of the teams is to be carried out accurately by the SSCA Grading Committee before the season commences this will need to be looked at more carefully. The SSCA Recorder and Competition Manager, whoever he should be in coming seasons, needs to be able to monitor this task more easily and this can only be achieved by better management by the Clubs in this endeavour.

Getting back to the season proper, there was a "grand total" of 87 centuries scored by the batsmen across the grades, with no less than 13 scores of over 150 & 2 "DOUBLE CENTURIES" being accredited, one each to Daniel Gordon (201no in the B6 grade) & Evan Horvatt (200 in the B2 grade). 16 Players scored 2 or more centuries with Daniel Brett (B3 grade) having 4 centuries to his name. The bowlers also had considerable success with them achieving no less than 27 x 7wicket hauls which included 2 x 8 wicket & 1 x 9 wicket bags in that number. 10 "hat-tricks" were also achieved by the bowlers throughout the season. There was also a further 8/44 in the C2 Semi-Final to Gynea Bay CC player Simon Grigg & 7/45 in the A1 Final to Como – Jannali player Jimmy Gardner.

In the Finals games there were only 4 Minor Premiers successful with 4 second placed teams and 2 third placed teams also gaining Premiership victories.

I would like to congratulate all of the Premiership winning teams and all of the SSCA Award Winners & hope that everyone is able to return next season to make that an equally successful season and being a "Double Ashes Season" it is hoped that the numbers of players returning can increase, especially if the Australian Cricket team can rise to the occasion.

Two Scorebooks were submitted and both were considered worthy of an award for Eric Catt (B4) and Judy Lofthouse (B6). Congratulations to both of these stalwarts.

I would personally like to thank all of the SSCA Management Committee, Tom (the Cricket Online Administrator) Croucher, the Club committees, Team Captains, players and those people at the Sutherland Shire Council that are responsible for the grounds that we are permitted to play on throughout the season, for making the 2012/13 season a really successful one. It has been a real "eye-opener" in my first season as the SSCA Recorder and Competition Manager and although it was extremely difficult at times, what with some of the problems that have arisen, I have thoroughly enjoyed myself.
