SSCA RECORDER AND COMPETITION MANAGER'S REPORT

The 2014/15 Sutherland Shire Cricket Association (SSCA) season got underway in August with the nomination & grading of 69 teams from the 16 clubs currently affiliated with the SSCA which was a drop of 6 teams from the previous season. There were 11 grades comprising 7 X 7 teams & 4 X 5 teams in the competitions when play got underway on the 13th September, 2014. However, the unfortunate withdrawal of a team from the B5 competition after only two rounds saw the SSCA having to fall back on the wisdom of our “trusty” Secretary, Michael Mooney to formulate a complete restructure of those competitions from the B5 grade downwards. This ended up seeing a 10 grade structure of the competitions with 9 X 7 team competitions from the A1's down to B7's & with the remaining 5 teams being in the C1's competition. Although some teams had queries as to the reasoning for this & could not completely understand this it was extremely unfortunate, but absolutely necessary!!!

The late registration of players after the nominations were received in August 2014 still remains a problem & does cause quite a bit of extra work for those people concerned with the monitoring, approval & (now) the registering of these players into their correct grades compliant with the player's abilities. The process we adopted this season of all late registrations being completed by the SSCA will continue into the new season. Whilst there is significantly more work involved, it is the only way that we can effectively monitor late registrations being registered into correct grades.

At the end of the season there were a total of 1289 players registered in the 68 teams that completed the 2014/2015 SSCA season, a slight drop of around 125 players from the 2013/2014 season but similarly consistent with the drop of the 6 teams from this previous season. Keeping in mind that there were some teams in this seasons competitions that comprised well over 20 players registered in them, perhaps the clubs could look to reduce the numbers of players in these teams comparable to the individual player's abilities, to try to increase the number of teams & therefore to increase the number of the grades that the SSCA can have each season. By having players in grades compatible to their respective abilities this would even out each competition & would see teams having a greater chance of succeeding in more competitive grades.

Throughout the season there were of nine (9) forfeitures of matches across the grades – this is a very disturbing trend for the Committee to observe. There were also eleven (11) duty failures throughout the season that saw a number of clubs & their teams heavily penalised – the Committee takes no pleasure in penalising teams and clubs in this way however if all clubs are proactive they can address the problem of players not being available and prevent these occurrences happening again in coming seasons.

The late entry of the ‘Cricket Online Match Results’ was still an ongoing problem, although this has improved with the introduction of the “home team” having the sole responsibility of the entry of the match results into the On-line site. Once we get everyone to achieve accurate & ‘on time’ entry of the Online Match results then the SSCA Points Tables & Team/Player statistics & therefore accurate quotients can be maintained correctly & on a regular basis. The recording of the ‘Duty Umpires’ names in their Online Match Results is extremely important in maintaining an accurate & true record of the SSCA Points Tables in the Online. To those clubs, captains & scorers that maintained an accurate & timely entry of their results each round, I once again thank you for your assistance.

After the 14 rounds of the SSCA competitions in all grades there were a total of 78 Centuries scored in all grades with Illawong-Menai B5/1 player Daniel Foster achieving three (3) of these

& with the highest total of 196 also. There were also 15 other players achieving two (2) centuries each amongst those 78 scored.

There were also 17 players to achieve the 19 recorded 7 or more wickets in an innings that is usually recognised in the SSCA competitions. Of these Miranda RSL B2 player Ryan Turner achieved a 9 for 32 in Rd 14 & also with Miranda Magpies B2 player David Hatherly achieving 8 for 29 in Rd 14 & Ben Towell achieving 8 for 58 standing out as well.

Three (3) players achieved “Hat Tricks” this season, them being St.Patrick's B6/1 player James Almond, 6 for 52 in Rd 6, DLS Seagulls B6 player Andrew Whittingham, 3 for 10 in Rd 10 & Bangor Comets C1 player Ryan Shepherd, 3 for 11 in Rd 3.

Of the 16 clubs in total there were only 8 clubs represented in the 2014/15 SSCA Finals' matches. There were seven (7) Minor Premiers successful in these Finals along with two (2) Runners up & one (1) 3rd placed teams also successful.

The Como-Jannali Cricket Club's A1, A2 & B1 teams, by being victorious in their respective Finals matches, may have set a precedent in that they could be the only club to achieve victories in the “top 3 grades” in the one season. Congratulations to that Club for this magnificent effort.

There did appear to be a very disturbing increase in the reporting of “disciplinary problems” throughout the 2014/15 season that saw a number of players suspended & fines issued. All of the clubs will need to stress to their Team Captains & players that The MCC Laws Of Cricket & The SSCA Bylaws that teams play under in the SSCA competitions are there for the sole benefit of maintaining the game of cricket in the Sutherland Shire & to ensure that the very “long standing traditions” of this great game are upheld & to also ensure that everyone can enjoy their matches during their Spring, Summer & Autumn weekends.

A big personal “Thank You” must go to all of the SSCA Management Committee, Tom Croucher (SSCA Cricket Online Administrator), the SSCUA (Umpires) Committee & their members, the various Club Committees, the Team Captains/Scorers/Players, the Sutherland Shire Council & Staff for the grounds that are played on each season & to all those other people that have made this 2014/15 season a successful one. I also personally hope that the coming 2015/16 season can be an ongoing success.
