SECRETARYS REPORT

This season has seen a number of disruptions and difficult playing conditions due to the ongoing drought followed by bushfires and other weather conditions however we made it through to the finals before the shutdowns and exclusions resulting from the Covid-19 pandemic.

Both the President and the Competition Manager have highlighted the fact that the entry of team lists before a match and the recording of results in a timely manner (by 7:00pm on the Monday following each match). Once again it seems to me that all statistics have not been recorded in MyCricket given the number of grades where players that did not reach the qualifying number of runs / wickets / dismissals. I remind all Clubs (and particularly those who are tasked with recording match results and player statistics) that MyCricket is the only source I have for recording end of year results and player statistics for the Annual Report.

Thank you for the work put in by all committee members to ensure that the SSCA competitions are run

smoothly for the benefit of all players. Your commitment and contributions are very much appreciated. I wish also to record my thanks to Kevin & Daniel McGrath for their contributions rearranging and updating the By-Laws, Playing Conditions and drafting the newly introduced SSCA Member Protection Policy

This season, as in previous seasons, we have worked with Sutherland Council to carry out necessary ground improvements as part of the ongoing plans in conjunction with the SSJCA.

We have also made significant commitments to assist the SSJCA with the construction of additional training nets at Solander Fields and Box Road at Sylvania as well as Gynea Bay CC with the upgrade of the nets at Gynea Bay Oval.

There will (more likely than not) be a change to the start of our 2020/21 season but at the time of writing this report it is not clear what these changes will be. I am heartened by a recent communique from Cricket

Australia's Executive General Manager Community Cricket that their current focus is, *inter alia*, developing return to play guidelines & resources to support a quick & safe return to the field and ensuring that all Cricket Australia programs and systems are ready to go when the season starts. This includes making sure that the current MyCricket is stable and ready when the green light is given.

Also in relation to MyCricket, Cricket Australia is foreshadowing plans for a new MyCricket system for the 2022/23 season and onwards. Hopefully more user friendly!!

Thank you to Kookaburra for their generous sponsorship and to Sutherland Council for their on-going support of cricket in the Shire.

Congratulations to all premiership winning teams and individual award winners for the season.

Harry was a Life Member of the SSCA. He contributed to the SSCA as a player with Heathcote, Southern United and Engadine Dragons achieving many awards and also as a representative player, captain and manager. Harry was manager of the successful Martin Shield team in 1969/70. Harry was for many years the SSCA honorary Auditor.

Harry was also a Life Member of the Engadine Dragons Cricket Club and was heavily involved as a club administrator, coach and manager of many junior teams with considerable success.

Harry also volunteered as a selector for many representative teams for the SSJCA.

Harry's contribution to cricket was recognised with Cricket Australia's 50 years service medal.

SSCA RECORDER AND COMPETITION MANAGER'S REPORT

The 2019-20 SSCA cricket season got under way with the initial team nominations on the 5th August, 2019 & whereby there were 46 teams ultimately nominated from the affiliated clubs. This was a substantial and very disappointing drop off of 9 teams from the previous 2018-19 SSCA season.

The continual drop in player registrations and team numbers is a problem that needs to be redressed with a concerted effort from all concerned, otherwise we are going to see this fine Cricket Association continuing to lose numbers.

Total senior SSCA Registrations (MyCricket Dashboard) were shown as being 969, a drop off of 97 from the previous season. The total SSCA registration numbers were made up with a total of 301 late registrations across all of the clubs, and this really needs to be addressed by the clubs if they wish to see their costs reduced. Perhaps the clubs may need to have earlier registration dates as do the various football codes throughout the Shire, and this may see a proposal coming from the SSCA Management Committee to facilitate this.

The 46 teams were graded into 5 X 5 team competitions comprising 15 rounds of matches (IE:- A1, A2, B1, B2 and B3) and 3 X 7 team competitions comprising of 14 rounds of matches.

The 2019-20 SSCA season also saw a couple of rounds severely compromised by the disastrous bushfires & then the extremely wet weather that had hit NSW before and after the Christmas/New Year break & these conditions were completely out of the control of the SSCA Management Committee as we had to abide by the higher authorities in how we managed our cricket.

It is well known that players are restricted by the number of matches that they can be involved in throughout a SSCA season due to circumstances such as increased weekend work commitments etc., but there was also a preponderance for a number of teams across various clubs to have exceptional numbers of players registered into them that could see many players failing to secure the required number of matches to qualify them for the ultimate SSCA Semi-Finals'/Finals' matches at the season's end. A reduction in player numbers per team would correct this, and it would/could also see an increase in team numbers across the board & possibly an increase in the number of grades that can be had right across the board.

With the MyCricket System of registrations in use for the third season there are still some minor difficulties being had that will be sorted out eventually. It must be remembered by the various Club Secretaries/Senior Registrars that a player cannot participate in any SSCA competition matches unless he has been correctly registered through the MyCricket Registration/Play Cricket System and then nominated into a particular club's team before he/she can play.

After the SSCA AGM/Adjourned AGM the SSCA Management Committee introduced a new method of having the particular SSCA By-Laws & the SSCA Playing Conditions split into 2 separate documents that appeared to have made the running of the teams much simpler.

With regards to the MyCricket Match Details/Results carried out during the 2019-20 SSCA season there was a very disappointing number of teams across all of the grades that are still not conversant with the **early** recording of their online results with a total of 18 teams

being penalised. With the results that were recorded there were an extreme number of these that failed to record the full required and accurate match details that the SSCA Management Committee needs to see all of the team and player statistics recorded accurately. If players miss out on Club Awards or SSCA Awards then the captains/scorers are to be blamed. This had also seen only (around) 37% of teams gaining the newly introduced system of having 1 bonus point awarded to the 'home team[s]' for recording their MyCricket Match Details/Results in a full and accurate manner as requested by the Association.

Although this did not actually have much of an effect on the final SSCA Points Scores and the ultimate positions for the Semi-Finals'/Finals, this could have an effect in coming seasons.

There were a disappointing number of forfeits during the season that saw 6 teams (1 team twice) being penalised. Although a drop off of 5 teams from the previous season, this still cannot be tolerated.

There were also 3 teams that failed to carry out their duty team obligations that saw them penalised. This was also an improvement on the previous season, but still will not be tolerated.

With regards to the SSCA Semi-Finals' matches there was a surprising incidence of 5 of the 8 teams making the semi-finals that were placed 3rd in the points' scores.

Further, in the Finals' matches there were 5 of the Minor Premiers to achieve success in these matches, 1 X 2nd place team & 2 of the 3rd placed teams being successful. These results must surely indicate that most of the grades were evenly contested throughout the 2019/20 SSCA season.

Results of these SSCA Semi-Finals' & Finals' matches are published in other sections of the Annual Report.

Congratulations must go to all those players that have achieved SSCA Awards & Team Awards.

Any player that feels that they should have gained any of these awards can only have their team captains/scorers to blame if the results & statistics do not meet up with what has been recorded in the MyCricket Match Details/Results.

I would personally like to thank all of the members of the SSCA Management Committee for their greatly appreciated assistance throughout the season that has helped make my job that much easier.

I would also like to thank the SSCUA Committee & its' members for their able assistance in managing those matches under their control when appointed during the season.

The Sutherland Shire Council must also receive gratitude for the sometimes difficult task of supplying the SSCA & its' members with suitable grounds to play on each round.

This season has seen some previously mentioned disastrous interruptions that the Council has done its' best to come to terms with.

Last but not least I would also like to thank all of the Club Committees and their players for making the 2019-20 season a success.

Although we cannot all be winners, we can still have fun playing the sport that we love!!!
