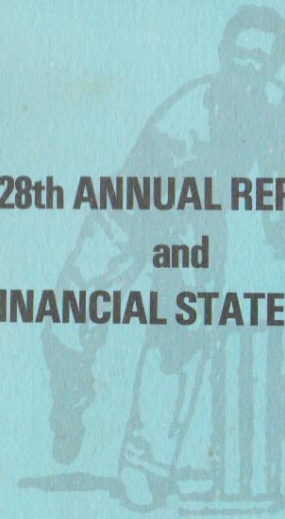

CRICKETER OF THE YEAR

"JOHN WOODHOUSE MEMORIAL TROPHY"

JEFF SMITH

We are very proud to announce our Junior Cricketer of the Year is Jeffery Smith of the Como Club.

Jeffery had an outstanding season in his 1st year of 16A's and whether you look at his performance this year or look at his overall performance at both club and representative levels since his career started as a 7 year old, you could only feel admiration for his achievements and also be pleased that he played for and not against us.

Jeffery captained and Vice-captained many club and representative sides with distinction, leading by example and showing a maturity far in excess of his age. Jeffery is sometimes stern but always pleasant towards members of his sides and gentle and caring for the younger ones.

Jeffery played his club cricket with Como, except for one season with Illawong.

His amazing performance in six years of reps. saw five premierships on the trot and as semi-finalists this last season. In 16A's he amassed 447 runs (Ass. Agg.) at 37.25 (2nd in Ass.) and he took 19 wickets at 18.68 from 138 overs, conceding only 2.57 runs per over.

Jeffery joined the Como Club in the 1977/78 season in 10c's and they came 2nd in the competition - the 1978/79 season saw them take the premiership. As Jeffery was still eligible to play in the Under 10 competition, we show his career records from :

- 1982/83 Club Illawong, 14A Vice Captain. 312 runs at 39, 20 wickets at 14.35. Representative - Moore Shield No. 1 Premiers. Selected N.S.W.C.A. U/13 Metropolitan Coaching Squad.
- 1983/84 Club Como. 14A captain. 512 runs at 56.88 and 23 wickets at 15.78. Representative Moore Shield No. 1 Premiers. Won Cliff Paddy Memorial Award for Best Performance by a Rep. player. N.S.W.C.A. U/14 Metropolitan Coaching Squad.
- 1984/85 Club Como 16A Captain. 447 runs (Ass. Agg.) at 37.25 and 19 wickets at 18.68. Representative Watson Shield, Vice Capt. - semi-finalists. Sutherland Green Shield - Premiers. N.S.W.C.A. U/15 Metropolitan Coaching Squad.

From the 10A competition through to the 16A competition, Jeffery accumulated a total of 2719 runs at an ave. of 45.86.

BEST PERFORMANCE - 14A GRADE 'SUTHERLAND DISTRICT CRICKET CLUB AWARD'

Peter Magee from Cronulla Seagulls won this award for his brilliant all-round play during the season. Peter won the bowling average and aggregate including a hat-trick and was 2nd in the batting average. He was in the Moore (1) representative team. Peter was selected to re-trial for the N.S.W.C.A. Coaching squad. Also considered were A. Hale, P. Garment, G. Davison, D. Digby.

BEST PERFORMANCE - 12A GRADE 'SUTHERLAND UNITED SERVICES CLUB TROPHY'

Matthew Napier of Caringbah Sports completed a brilliant wicket-keeping season by finishing 2nd in batting average and aggregate. A good all-round performance. Matthew, was in the unlucky Causey (4) team. Also considered were B. Davison, S. Webster, T. Brennan, J. Hall, J. Packer.

RECORDERS REPORT

The continued enthusiasm of boys to play and enjoy the game of Cricket in the 1980's was reflected in the number of teams and players who participated in our 1984/85 competition.

It is worth a reminder that the workload on the Dads who give up their time for free to carry out the "Behind the scene" administrative duties, continues at an ever-increasing level. The workload is not getting less and requires more and more helpers, therefore it was encouraging when the Association broke new ground this season. FOUR (4) NEW DELEGATES offered their services

to be competition recorders. Recording the weekend results involves a considerable amount of paperwork. The result sheets handed in by your team managers are important. The figures show match results and individual performances, therefore they form the basis of records to show competition winners & individual trophy winners.

The sheets should be filled out clearly and accurately, otherwise a club, a team or a player can be penalised, perhaps unfairly. Remember the recorder is not at your particular game.

The assistance received from clubs this year together with our record four recorders made for smooth running of the 145 teams. Competition fines and penalties were less this season than previously. We thank you for your support.

Once again, our association has co-operated with the Men's Association by installing another five synthetic surfaces on pitches within the Sutherland Shire. With such a large number of our wickets now covered, a greater number of our players from A grade through to lower grades are now having the advantage of these surfaces.

The move to more and more wickets covered with artificial turf is making for better cricket. Urge new Dads to come along to the Annual General Meeting & put their names down for some duty that will make our 1985/86 season even more enjoyable for boys in the Sutherland Shire.

Congratulations to the successful competition winners and the boys who are to receive individual awards.

REGISTRAR'S REPORT

In the 1984/85 season, 1824 boys were registered in the 145 teams playing in the Sutherland Shire Junior Cricket Association. Boys playing with the Association for the first time numbered 651, of whom 315 were under 10 years of age and 198 were under 12 years of age as at 1st October, 1984.

Details of the steady growth in registrations over the past five seasons are as follows -

There are 19 junior associations affiliated with the Junior Union with a total of nearly 17,000 players. Following Parramatta, Sutherland has the largest number of boys playing Junior cricket. The Junior Union was again headed by George Weblin as President and John Crane as Secretary.

Sutherland Shire Junior Association were again successful in taking out the coveted Shell Company Shield, for the third successive season, but by the barest of margins. This was most commendable considering our representative teams were unable to take out a final. During the season our management committee member and delegate to the Junior Union, Claude Mann, was appointed Manager of an Under 14 Junior Union team touring the far North Coast of New South Wales. The team returned unbeaten. Claude also was appointed selector for the Northern Territory under 15 touring team.

Three Sutherland Shire boys were selected in the team to tour the Northern Territory during May, 1985. The boys were Grant Geraghty, Darren Holly and Darrell Mann. - well done boys.

During the season a move was made to alter the Junior Union rules to provide for all inter-association representative matches on Sundays. We were pleased to report our opposition to this move was successful. For the ones no longer eligible for the Under 16, all the best for the future in both your sporting, and where applicable, business careers.

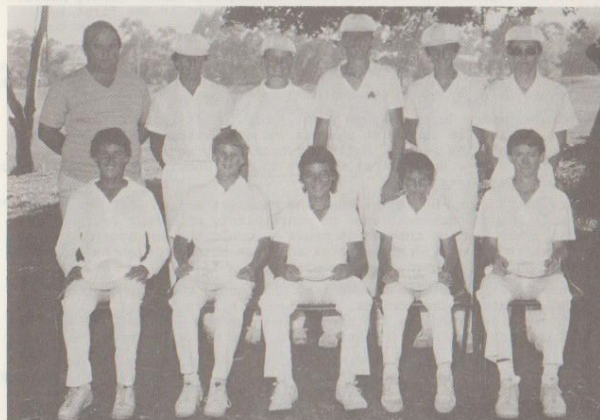
